

Outline Rules/Timetable

1. Entry forms are to be completed and returned to the Worshipful Company of Pewterers' by 15 April 2019. These are downloadable from www.pewterers.org.uk or by email from info@pewterers.org.uk . *Please note these must be typed and emailed.*
2. High resolution images (JPEG or TIFF over 1mb ideally) must accompany the entry form by 15 April 2019. NB this information and the images will be used in the catalogue and for other publicity purposes with rights retained by the Pewterers' Company.
3. There are three possible categories to enter below but please note that although you can enter more than one item you cannot enter the same piece in multiple categories. You must include a 50 word description for each entry.
4. All pieces are to be made by the competition finalists at their own expense but pewter will be supplied on application to the Company, in special cases. *For recommended suppliers of Pewter please see below or go to www.pewterers.org.uk .*
5. Finalists must deliver 3-D final entries, clearly labelled with full contact details to Pewterers' Hall by 7 May 2019. *Entrants must take Health and Safety/EU Regulations into account which apply, for example, to the restricted use of pewter for door handles in public buildings (melting point of pewter is 225-240°C).*
6. The work of all the finalists will be on display in Pewter Live 2019, from 21 – 23 May 2019 (open to public 10.00-17.00 on 22 May) at Pewterers' Hall and the winners will be announced at 11.45 on Thursday 23 May 2019, at Pewterers' Hall.
7. All competing students and tutors are invited to attend at 11.45 on 23 May 2019 for the Prize-giving Ceremony (invitation only). We understand that it is expensive to travel to London for this event so the Company is willing to subsidise tickets of those unable to afford the fare on a case basis. 8. Entrants should undertake their own insurance and design protection.
9. The Worshipful Company of Pewterers' retains the right to use images submitted in publicity/marketing material produced by the Company.
13. The designer or group of designers can employ others to make their submission, if they wish.
14. The judges' decision is final on all matters.
15. Return of designs: Entrants are to collect their entries and designs at the end of the Prizegiving on 23 May 2019 (approximately 14.00). Any items not collected by 1st July 2019 will be disposed of.
