John discussed the hospital grade cleaning process used by the district including a demonstration with UV light disinfection. Other methods include air diffusers and hepa vacuum filters. The district has planned and now in the process of upgrading the HVAC systems at both Parkview and Thorson. Cost for this project is 3.5 million. The district is also utilizing a student work program for buildings and grounds which has saved the district 250k/annually and allowed to offer jobs to kids in the community.
