





#### 6 day Escorted Tour

DAY 1 DELHI Your tour commences with an arrival transfer to your hotel. Overnight at Hotel the Royal Plaza (4 star) or The Park Hotel (5 star).

DAY 2 DELHI Your full day sightseeing of Old and New Delhi begins with a ride by cycle rickshaw, through the colourful laneways of Chandni Chowk Market followed by a visit to Jama Masjid, one of the largest mosques in India. Overnight at Hotel Clarks Shiraz (4 star) or Jaypee Palace Hotel (5 star). (B)



DAY 4 AGRA - JAIPUR Early this morning you will have the opportunity to witness the Taj Mahal at sunrise (optional - to be paid locally). Afterwards travel to Fatehpur Sikri to explore the fascinating ghost city before continuing on to Jaipur known as the Pink City, the colourful capital of Rajasthan. 

#### 10 day Private Tour

**DAY 1 JODHPUR** Your tour commences with an arrival transfer to your hotel. Overnight at Indana Palace Jodhpur (4 star), Ajit Bhawan (5 star) or RAAS Jodhpur (Heritage).

**DAY 2 JODHPUR** Early morning visit to Bishnoi Villages by jeep, followed by a tour to Mehrangarh Fort, one of the most impressive and formidable structures in Rajasthan. Inside its boundaries are several palaces known for their intricate carvings and expansive courtyards showcasing the splendour and glamour of a bygone era. **DAY 5 NAGAUR – JAISALMER** Drive to Jaisalmer across the desert, witnessing its magic as the city shimmers like a mirage in the distance. The golden sandstone walls and narrow streets lined with exquisitely carved buildings, through which camel carts trudge leisurely, has an extraordinarily medieval feel and an incredible atmosphere. Overnight at Fort Rajwada (4 star), Jaisalmer Marriot Resort & Spa (5 star), Killa Bhawan (Heritage). (B)

**DAY 6 JAISALMER** Today visit Jaisalmer Fort (Sonar Fort) one of the largest fully preserved fortified cities in the world, standing amongst the sandy expanse of the great Thar Desert. Walking down the narrow-cobbled stone lanes, one can feel the sheer magic of Jaisalmer. This afternoon, visit the Havelis with beautifully carved facades including the Salim Singh Haveli which is especially attractive. Enjoy an evening excursion to Sam Sand Dunes for a memorable dinner under the stars. (B, D)

**DAY 7 JAISALMER – ROHET GARH** After breakfast drive to Rohet Garh, where on arrival you will check in at Rohet Garh Hotel (Heritage)\*, one of Rajasthan's most appealing heritage hotels. The remainder of your day is at leisure to relax and soak up the atmosphere of this grand hotel. (B)
