NWGA-USBC All-Star Qualifier's Tournament Rules

Entry is open to members of the Northwest Georgia USBC Association who have bowled a minimum of 12 games in a NWGA-USBC league. PBA members can bowl, but by the rules of the Georgia State B.A. All-Star Tournaments, they cannot represent the NWGA-USBC Association; however, they will be recognized as a NWGA-USBC Association All-Star, Senior All-Star or Super Senior All-Star, if qualifying. A PBA member is anyone applying for or holding a 2015, 2016 or 2017 PBA card.

The entry fee is \$55.00 per bowler. **CERTIFIED CHECK OR MONEY ORDER** should be used to pay entry fees. Make checks payable to **NWGA USBC Association Tournament Fund**. **A \$30.00 ADMINISTRATIVE FEE, PLUS BANK CHARGES WILL BE LEVIED ON ANY RETURNED CHECK.** \$18.00 per entry will be used to pay lineage and \$7.00 will go to tournament expenses. The remaining fees, including the association share of other income, will be used to pay the entry fees for no more than two teams in each of the State All-Star Tournaments (*\$60.00 per person last year*). The remaining funds will be distributed equally among the bowlers of these teams after they participate in the State Tournament.

This tournament will have 3 divisions:

Regular = No age requirements

Senior = 50 or older as of March 17, 2018

Super Senior = 60 or older as of March 3, 2018

When registering for this tournament, an eligible participant can choose to enter a 2nd and/or a 3rd division if they are eligible to bowl in that event at the state level for an additional cost of \$35.00 per event.

The total cost to bowl:

1 event = \$ 55.00

2 events = \$ 90.00

3 events = \$125.00

Participants may enter up to 30 minutes prior to each squad in the order of receipt of entry fee (**Cash Only**) and based on lane availability. Advance entries are encouraged to assure inclusion and may be paid by certified check or money order. Each squad may be limited as to the number of bowlers. Entry forms must include the name of league and bowling center in which the entrant participates in league play.

This is a Scratch tournament. All entrants will bowl six (6) games across 12 lanes. The number of teams that NWGA sends to the State Tournament for each of these divisions will be determined by the total number of bowlers participating in each division. A minimum of 11 participants are required to send one team to the State Tournament and a minimum of 20 participants are required to send a 2nd team. After all entrants in each division have bowled, the Bowler of the Year, Senior Bowler of the Year and Super Senior Bowler of the Year (not required to compete for positions) and the top five qualifiers from each division will represent the association as members of the first team with the next six making up the second team in each of the state tournaments. If there are not enough participants to send at least one team to any of the State All-Star tournaments, NWGA will refund \$35.00 to each participant.

The association will only provide shirts for the members of 2 teams for each of the State Tournaments.

If any of the tournaments allow more than two teams from NWGA, members of these additional teams will pay their own entry into the tournament and will receive NO additional funds or shirts from this association.

In the event a bowler cannot participate in the state tournament, alternates will be selected in the order of finish until a team is filled (seventh moves to sixth and 13th moves to 12th, etc.). In the event of a tie for last position(s), the tied bowlers will drop their lowest game/s until the tie is broken. If a qualifier does not show up at the State Tournament, he/she will NOT be eligible for the next two years, but may appeal (in the event of an emergency) to the Board of Directors. The board decision will be final.

USBC playing rules will apply. Protest affecting eligibility or playing rules, must be in writing to the Tournament Supervisor or Manager within seven days of the date games bowled. Errors in scoring must be reported to the Tournament Supervisor or Manager within 24 hours. Rules not covered will be decided by the Tournament Supervisor or Manager and their decision is final unless appealed in accordance with USBC Rule 329.

Proper attire must be worn. Shorts must be within two inches of the knee, mini-skirts, T-Shirt underwear, sleeveless shirts and tank tops are prohibited. Hats may not be worn during competition. Cell phone use is prohibited. Smoking and alcoholic consumption regulations are controlled by the center, local/state laws and must be obeyed.
