

Consent Form in terms of the Protection of Personal Information Act, Act No. 4 of 2013

Consent to Process Personal Information (including Special Personal Information)

1. By agreeing to the terms of this consent form, you, the Parent/Guardian, hereby voluntarily authorise Designed to Dance (“DTD”) to process your Personal Information as well as that of the learner (“the Scholar”), including any Special Personal information as defined in Protection of Personal Information Act, 2013.
2. DTD will use reasonable and appropriate efforts in order to ensure that any Personal Information and/or Special Personal Information, as envisaged in Section 1 of the Protection of Personal Information Act, 2013, provided by you, or which is collected from you, the Scholar and/or third parties, is stored in a secure manner.
3. You agree to provide honest, accurate and current information about yourself and the Scholar to DTD and to maintain and update such information when necessary.
4. You herewith agree and consent that your Personal Information and/or Special Personal Information (and that of the Scholar) collected by DTD may be used for the following reasons:
 - 4.1 To carry out actions reasonably necessary in terms of DTD’s performance of any applicable service;
 - 4.2 To comply with statutory and regulatory requirements in respect of the storage and maintenance of documents and information;
 - 4.3 To comply with valid requests for information, including subject access requests and requests in terms of the Promotion of Access to Information Act 2 of 2000;
 - 4.4 To comply with information requests by regulators or bodies lawfully requesting the information;
 - 4.5 To comply with an obligation imposed by law on DTD;

- 4.6 To pursue the legitimate interests of DTD or of a third party to whom the information is lawfully supplied;
 - 4.7 To protect your legitimate interests and those of the Scholar;
 - 4.8 For internal purposes such as training and monitoring; and
 - 4.9 To assist in law enforcement and anti-money laundering and counter-terrorist financing initiatives.
5. You acknowledge that any Personal Information and/or Special Personal Information supplied to DTD in terms of this consent form is provided voluntarily to DTD. By submitting any Personal Information and/or Special Personal Information to DTD, in any form, you further acknowledge that such conduct constitutes an unconditional, specific and voluntary consent to the processing (including storage) of such Personal Information and/or Special Personal Information by DTD in terms of this consent form and/or under any applicable law in the manner contemplated in clause 4 above, which consent shall, in the absence of any written objection received from you, be indefinite and/or for the period otherwise required in terms of any applicable law.
6. You expressly consent that DTD may transfer, or otherwise make available any Personal Information and/or Special Personal Information about you or the Scholar to other parties who may process such Personal Information and/or Special Personal Information on behalf of DTD for the purposes detailed in clause 4.
7. In the event that you are of the view that DTD has utilised your Personal Information and/or Special Personal Information (or that of the Scholar) contrary to applicable law, you undertake to first attempt to resolve any concerns with DTD. If you are not satisfied with such process, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the Information Regulator, as envisaged in the Protection of Personal Information Act, 2013.
8. The provisions of this consent form shall survive the termination of our relationship for any reason whatsoever and shall remain in full force and effect notwithstanding such termination.
