

# V-Run 2018

## TERMS & CONDITIONS

### Rules & Regulations

#### **1. General**

- 1.1 V-Run 2018 (the "Event") is organised by Infinite Events Pte. Ltd. (the "Organiser"). These rules & regulations (as amended, supplemented or substituted from time to time, the "Rules") are applicable to Event participants (the "Participant" or "Participants"), and a copy may be found at [www.vrun.com.sg](http://www.vrun.com.sg) (the "Official Website"),
- 1.2 By continuing to use the Organiser's services, accessing any part of the Official Website, registering for the Event, submitting information to the Organiser (and/ or its related entities) whether for the purpose of registering for the Event or otherwise, or using any features of the Official Website, you signify that you have read, understood and agreed to be bound by the privacy policy set forth below (as amended, supplemented or substituted from time to time) in respect of the Organiser's collection, use and disclosure of your personal data (being information by which a person may be identified). Further, you hereby expressly agree and consent to the Organiser's (including its related entities', as well as their respective agents'), collection, use and disclosure of your personal data, for the Purposes (as defined in paragraph 6.8(ii) below). **The Participant may contact the Organiser at [admin@vrun.com.sg](mailto:admin@vrun.com.sg) if he has any questions about the collection, use or disclosure of his personal data.**
- 1.3 Completion of the online registration form confirms the Participants' agreement to abide by the Rules.
- 1.4 Registration for the Event is only confirmed upon the payment of the relevant registration fee and the issuance of a confirmation slip.
- 1.5 The Participant agrees:
  - (i) to provide true, accurate, current and complete information about himself/herself contained in the registration form (the "Registration Data");
  - (ii) maintain the security of his/her password and identification;
  - (iii) to maintain and promptly update the Registration Data to keep it true, accurate, current and complete;
  - (iv) that if he/she provides any information that is untrue, inaccurate, not current or incomplete, or if the Organiser has grounds to suspect that such information is untrue, inaccurate, not current or incomplete, the Organiser may suspend or terminate his/her registration and refuse any and all future use of the Official Website (or any parts thereof) by him/her;
  - (v) that the Organiser reserves the right to amend, supplement or substitute the Rules from time to time as the Organiser deems fit and without giving prior notification or any reasons thereof;
  - (vi) that the Organiser may contact the Participant from time to time by email and/or SMS and/or telephone calls. Any notice sent to the email address and/or SMS sent to the telephone number registered by the Participant with the Organiser shall be deemed as received by the Participant; and

- (vii) that the Organiser reserves the right to use any photographs, motion pictures, images, recordings, or any other records (whether in its original or edited form) of the Event or the Participants for any legitimate purposes, including commercial advertising and marketing, and/or to be uploaded onto the Official Website and/or for use by the Organiser, its affiliates and related organisations as publicity for its future events. The Participants acknowledge that the Organiser owns all rights to the photographs, motion pictures, recordings, or any other media records of the Event.
- 1.7 If there is ambiguity in any provision of the Rules, the Organiser shall be the sole authority to interpret them and in so doing, it may take into account the interests of all affected Participants. Any amendment, supplement or modification to the Rules will be updated on the Official Website.
- 1.8 The Organiser reserves the right to delay, cancel or change any details of the Event or any component of it without prior notice to the Participants. In such cases, every effort will be made to inform the Participants prior to the day/date of the Event. If the Event or any component of it is cancelled, there shall be no refund of the registration fees paid. The Organiser shall not be liable for any consequential loss or inconvenience caused.
- 2. Registration**
- 2.1 Registration is allowed only for multiples of 2 Participants (e.g. 2,4,6,8,10). Participants can choose to participate either in a team of 2 or multiples of 2.
- 2.2 The Organiser reserves the right to cancel or postpone the Event at any time without prior notice to the Participants, although the Organiser will use best efforts to inform the Participants prior to the date of the event, providing the reason(s) for the cancellation which may include but is not limited to force majeure events (e.g. acts of god, fire, war, civil commotion, disease outbreak). Please also refer to Paragraph 4.5 below. If the Event has to be cancelled or postponed, the registration fees paid by Participants are non-refundable and the Organiser shall not be liable, to the fullest extent permissible under law, for any other loss or inconvenience caused.
- 2.3 There will be no refund of registration fees for Participants who eventually do not take part in the Event, for whatever reason.
- 2.4 A Participant is strictly not allowed to transfer his or her Event entry (confirmation slip) to another party or participate under another person's name. The Organiser will not entertain nor be in any way responsible for any disputes arising from incomplete or inaccurate Registration Data.
- 2.5 The Organiser reserves the right to limit and refuse entry to any Participant on the day of the Event without providing any reasons thereof.
- 2.7 Participants are to ensure that their details and selected T-shirt size(s) are correct during registration as the Run-pack and all contents within the Run-pack are non-exchangeable. T-shirts sizes are issued on a first-come-first-served basis.
- 2.8 Participants below 18 years of age need parental or guardian consent, and the completed relevant indemnity form when registering online or in-person failing which the Organiser reserves the right to refuse entry to that Participant.
- 2.9 The Organiser reserves the right to close registration before the official closing date should participation reach its capacity.
- 2.10 The registration will only be completed when full payment is made.

### **3. Run-pack collection**

- 3.1 The Run-pack will not be issued to Participants after the designated collection dates. However, if a Participant is unable to collect on the designated dates, under exceptional circumstances (with valid reason(s)), and with special arrangement via email, the Participant may collect the Run-pack (before or after the Event) from the Organiser's office.
- 3.2 Please produce the confirmation slip and NRIC/Passport for collection of the Run-pack. The Organiser reserves the right to refuse collection by Participants who do not present the required documents.
- 3.3 If Participants are unable to collect their Run-packs in person, they may authorise a representative ("Representative") to collect on their behalf. The following documents must be presented when the representative collects the Run-pack:
  - (i) run-pack collection authorisation letter;
  - (ii) participant's confirmation slip;
  - (iii) photocopy of Participant's NRIC; and
  - (iv) photocopy of Representative's NRIC.

### **4. Run**

- 4.1 The Organiser reserves the right to amend, modify or change the Event route as it deems fit at any time without prior notice. The Organiser would usually only amend, modify or change the Event route if it deems fit for the safety of the Participant and/or to prevent any potential hazards in the operation of the Event. In such cases, every effort will be made to inform the Participant prior to the day/date of the Event. The Organiser shall not be liable for any other loss or inconvenience caused due to such changes. Participants are encouraged to check the Official Website for any such changes to the Event route the day before the Event. Participants will however, be informed of any change to the Event route on the day of and before the start of the Event.
- 4.2. Only registered Participants wearing the bib provided (in the Run-pack) with the assigned number will be allowed to participate in the Event. Bib numbers must be positioned at the front chest area of the Event T-Shirt (or your own t-shirt in the event that suitable sizes are unavailable) and must be worn throughout the entire Event, the bib number visible at all times along the Event route. Participants' bibs are non-transferable. Participants not wearing a bib may be taken off the Event route by security officers or route marshals.
- 4.3 As Participants below the age of 18 are required to seek parental/guardian consent and complete the relevant indemnity form when registering online, the Organiser reserves the right to refuse a Participant entry if documents are incomplete or if evidence of identification/age determination is un-available.
- 4.4 Participants are required to report at the designated start point of the Event at least 30 minutes prior to flag-off time. Latecomers will be given a grace period of 15 minutes after the flag-off time, after which they will be disallowed participation in the Event.
- 4.5 The Organiser reserves the right to delay the commencement of the Event in the event of inclement weather. Should the inclement weather persist after the delay, the Organiser reserves the right to cancel the Event without refund of registration fees. If it rains after the flag-off, Participants are advised to seek shelter along the Event route. Participants may continue with the Event at their own risk.

- 4.6 No pets are allowed. No gadgets which may interfere with or impede other Participants are allowed. Support vehicles, pacers, Personality Mobility Devices, wheel-run transport devices including but not limited to strollers, walking strollers, roller-skates, in-line skates, skateboards, skate-scooters, scooters, bicycles, prams, pushcarts, pushchairs, shoes with built-in or attached rollers, etc. are not permitted on the Event route.
- 4.7 While baggage deposit service is provided, commencing at 3.30pm when the Event opens, the Organiser shall not be liable, to the fullest extent permissible under the law, for any loss and/or damage, personal or otherwise, to the belongings and items deposited. The Organiser also reserves the right to check any item or baggage deposited. As the number of baggage deposit lockers are limited and provided on a first-come-first-served basis, Participants are encouraged to participate light, avoid bringing valuables, and use only the Run-pack bag collected at the Run-pack collection. For security reasons, only bags that are smaller than 20cm x 15 cm are permitted on the race route.
- 4.8 For security reasons, the Organiser reserves the right to:
- (i) request Participants to open their un-deposited bags for inspection; and/or
  - (ii) remove any unattended bags at the Event premises in which event the Organiser will not be responsible for any losses and/or damages to the belongings.
- 4.9 The Organiser reserves the right to limit and refuse entry to prohibited areas without assigning any reasons thereof.
- 4.10 Should any participant feel unwell in the course of the race, he/she should stop and seek immediate medical attention at the designated medical posts.
- 4.11 A Participant shall retire from the Event immediately if required to do so by any member of the official medical staff, Event officials, referee and/or security officer for any reason whatsoever, including but not limited to reasons of safety or medical reasons.
- 4.12 As the Event is a fun run, run timings will not be recorded.

## **5. Medical & Safety**

- 5.1 Whilst reasonable precautions will be taken by the Organiser to ensure Participants' safety, Participants are advised to exercise due care. Participants participate at their own risk and the Organiser, its sponsors and its appointed officials shall not be liable, to the fullest extent permissible by law, for any death or injury, loss or damage suffered, personal or otherwise, and howsoever arising, by the Participant from training for or during participation in the Event.
- 5.2 The Organiser reserves the right to remove any participant deemed physically incapable of continuing with the Event to prevent him/her from causing greater harm and injury to himself/herself.
- 5.3 Participants are strongly encouraged to consult their medical practitioner to certify them fit to participate in the Event prior to registration and before the actual day of the Event. For the safety of other participants, Participants are advised to run on the designated Event route and observe traffic regulations.
- 5.4 Participants are advised to be well rested and hydrated prior to the Event.

- 5.5 For safety reasons, the following persons are restricted from participating in the Event:
- (i) mothers running with their babies in baby carriers; or
  - (ii) expectant mothers unless the expectant mothers provide a medical certificate from a qualified gynaecologist in Singapore (other than the expectant mother or her family member) and certify that she is fit to participate in the Event. The certificate should be dated within 7 days of the Event.

**6. Declaration, Representation, Warranty, Undertaking and Waiver by Participant**

- 6.1 I fully understand and acknowledge the risks involved in my participation in the Event and I accept full responsibility and assume all such risks.
- 6.2 I hereby represent, warrant and undertake to the Organisers the following with full knowledge that they shall be relied upon by the Organisers in accepting my registration: -
- (i) my personal particulars disclosed in the registration form are accurate, full and complete;
  - (ii) I do not have any medical condition that would affect my safety or physical well-being.
  - (iii) I am medically and physically fit and competent to participate in the Event; and
  - (iv) I shall dutifully and fully abide by the Rules and any applicable laws.
- 6.3 I confirm that the representations, warranties and undertakings herein are true and accurate.
- 6.4 I (including my heirs, successors and assigns) undertake not to make any claims or lodge any complaints whatsoever against the Organisers, Sponsors or officials of the Event for any injury, death or loss/damage to property sustained during the Event/disputes over any matter in relation to the Event.
- 6.5 I (including my heirs, successors and assigns) agree to hold the Organisers, Sponsors, appointed officials/suppliers (each an 'Indemnified Party') harmless and keep each Indemnified Party fully and effectively indemnified from and against any and all losses, costs (including legal costs on a full indemnity basis), claims, damage and expenses whatsoever which any of them may incur (directly or indirectly) as a result of my breach of any provision of the Rules.
- 6.6 Any disputes arising from the participation in the Event shall be referred to and finally resolved by arbitration to be conducted in Singapore in accordance with the Arbitration Rules of the Singapore International Arbitration Centre ("**SIAC Rules**") for the time being in force, which rules are deemed to be incorporated by reference in this paragraph. The Tribunal shall consist of 3 arbitrator(s) to be appointed by the Chairman of the SIAC. The language of the arbitration shall be English.
- 6.7 I am agreeable to the Organiser, its affiliate and related organisations and/or its appointed vendors to verify and record my personal particular communicate with me (e.g. via sms, whatsapp, email, etc) on any service related updates with regards to the Event and the Organiser's future events that may interest me.

6.8 By registering for the Event, I

- (i) consent to the collection, use and disclosure of my personal data (and the personal data of my parent/guardian and/or Representative(s), where applicable) by the Organiser (or its agents) to its related entities, or third parties authorised by the Organiser, for the purpose of the processing, administration and promotion by the Organiser (or its agents) of the Event and all activities connected to the Event, and for the Organiser (or its agents) to comply with any applicable laws, insurance and other requirements (collectively, the “**Purposes**”), to the extent permitted by and in accordance with the Personal Data Protection Act 2012 (No. 26 of 2012), its implementing rules and regulations, and circulars of the Personal Data Protection Commission of Singapore, as these laws and regulations may be amended from time to time;
- (ii) warrant that where I disclose the personal data of my parent/guardian and/or Representative(s) (for Run-pack collection or otherwise) to the Organiser (or its agents), I have obtained the prior consent of my parent/guardian and such Representative(s) for the collection, use and disclosure by the Organiser (or its agents) of the personal data of such Representative(s) for the Purposes, in accordance with the applicable law, and
- (iii) agree that I will indemnify the Organiser in respect of any penalties, liabilities, claims, demands, losses and damages as a result of my breach of warranty.
