


A Special Tribute to Spennato's Ristorante — Our Place. Our Home.

Spennato's Ristorante is considered one of the finest restaurants in Summit County, and The North Summit Lions Club is proud to call it *OUR HOME*. Our bi-monthly meetings and many of our fundraisers are held here. Spennato's was opened in 2005 by N.S.L.C. member Egidio DiPaola (affectionately called "G") and his wife, Mary Lynn Randall.



 G was born in Sant Apollinare, Italy, one of 12 children in the family. He served in the Italian Navy for 6 years before coming to the U.S. in 1978. Before Spennato's, G made a name for himself with his popular Scotto's Pizza Shops. In fact, Spennato's front sign is inspired by the familiar Scotto's Pizza logo. G also ran the kitchens in Thistledown and Northfield Park racetracks.




 Spennato's is named after G's mother, Maria Spennato, and many of the recipes that are prepared daily are inspired by Maria's and his sisters' dishes they made in Italy. All of the restaurant's approximately 31 sauces are made from scratch, and all with fresh ingredients. Favorite dishes, like the fresh veal and chicken, are pounded daily.

She also decorated Spennato's interior, which includes authentic items from Italy. She commissioned the mural painting of Porto Fino, Italy by a local artist.

Outside of Mary's busy Spennato's schedule, she is quite the author. Her book, *Mardi Gras In Kodachrome*, features never-before-published photos of New Orleans, which were taken by her grandmother, Ruth I. Ketcham, in the 1940's and 1950's.
