**RE: Bawlf Wastewater System groundwater monitoring  
Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act Registration No. 00000400-02-00**

The Hydrogeological Assessment Report for Village of Bawlf Sewage Lagoon, dated March 4, 2016, prepared by Thurber Engineering Ltd., has been reviewed by our technical staff, and we concur with Thurber's recommendation that the groundwater wells to be monitored for water levels and chemistry until further notice in writing from the Director. The water levels shall be monitored twice per year, one in spring season and one in fall season. The water chemistry shall be monitored once per year. The monitoring data shall be interpreted by a professional registered with APEGA to determine if there is any adverse impact caused by the sewage lagoon.

The Village of Bawlf is obligated to comply with the requirements of *Code of Practice for Wastewater Systems using a Wastewater Lagoon*, which include maintaining the structural integrity of all portions of the wastewater lagoon as set out in the engineering design drawings and specifications.
