Family Fishing Weekend - Feb 16, 17, and 18

During Alberta's twice-yearly Family Fishing Weekends, no fishing license is required. Albertans and visitors are invited to give fishing a try on waterbodies with open fishing seasons (not in national parks). Keep in mind that fishing regulations still apply.
