### DOES YOUR DOG HAVE A 2019 DOG LICENSE TAG?

#### According to Bylaw Number 631/18:

1. A resident of Bawlf who is the Owner of any Dog aged six (6) weeks or older shall obtain a license for the Dog from the office of the Village of Bawlf as per Bylaw 629/18 – Master Rates Bylaw.

2. The Owner of every Dog shall, annually, on or before January 31<sup>st</sup>, renew the license for that Dog by submitting to the Village the annual licensing fee, as set out in Bylaw 629/18 – Master Rates Bylaw along with any other information as may be required by the Village.

**Schedule "A" Penalties: Part 3, Section 1: Failure to obtain dog license - first offence \$75.00, second offence \$150.00, third offence \$300.00**

### Summer in the Park - Notes for Parents and Guardians

- Children must be 5 years old as of June 30, 2019 and must be able to handle own personal hygiene needs. The program is not suitable for younger children.
- Children are expected to respect themselves, others and the program. Children who's behavior puts themselves or other children at risk will be sent home. Children have the right to attend the program but also the responsibility to follow the rules of the program and to behave accordingly.
- Every child must have a complete registration form before they are able to participate in the program. Please let the staff know if your child has any health concerns or special needs so that we can ensure they have the best time possible.
- In case of rain we will hold the day's program inside the community hall or arena. We will have signs directing you to the new location.
- The program will be relocated indoors if the temperature rises above 32°C. This is to prevent heat related emergencies such as heat cramps or heat stroke. A staff member will be at the park to let everyone know.
- Throughout the summer your child will be bringing home information describing what they have done and will be doing. Please take the time to read these with your children so that they come prepared.
- The program starts promptly at 10:00 am and is done at 2:00 unless otherwise indicated. Please ensure that your children are dropped off and picked up on time.
- Children are to remain at the program the entire day. If your child must leave early please have them bring a note.
