*County Enviro Pickup will take grass clippings and leaves, but please remember the 6 bag limit per week.

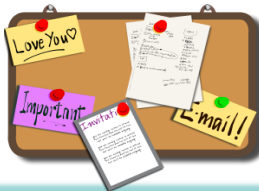
