\*Compass Municipal Services (Assessments) are preparing for their annual inspections of Village properties and you may have them come by to complete their work. They will have identification on them and it is your right to ask for it.

\*The Village Organizational Meeting was held October 22nd and as a result, John DeMerchant remains our Mayor and Ron Aschenbrenner assumes the role of Deputy Mayor.

\*Recently we have noticed that trailers and RVs have been parked on the roadways and wish to remind you of Bylaw 607/15.

-No person shall park or leave on any highway, within the Village, any trailer, whether designed for occupancy by persons, animals, or carrying of goods or equipment, unless said trailer is attached to a vehicle by which it may be propelled or drawn and when so attached the trailer shall be deemed part of the vehicle and shall be subject to the regulations pertaining to the vehicle, unless otherwise authorized by order of the Village Manager.

-No person shall leave or abandon any vehicle on a highway for more than seventy-two (72) consecutive hours.

-No person shall park a Recreation Vehicle upon a highway within the Village unless they are in the process of unloading or loading said vehicle.
