# DOES YOUR DOG HAVE A 2020 DOG LICENSE TAG?

Accordina to Bylaw Number 631/18:

1 A resident of Bawlf who is the Owner of any Dog aged six (6) weeks or older shall obtain a license for the Dog from the office of the Village of Bawlf as per Bylaw 629/18 - Master Rates Bylaw.

2. The Owner of every Dog shall, annually, on or before January 31st, renew the license for that Dog by submitting to the Village the annual licensing fee, as set out in Bylaw 629/18 – Master Rates Bylaw along with any other information as may be required by the Village.

Schedule "A" Penalties: Part 3, Section 1: Failure to obtain dog license first offence \$75.00, second offence \$150.00, third offence \$300.00
