Our target audience for the summit are youth and adults with disabilities, their family members and friends, school district professionals (counselors, school nurses, special education directors/teachers), social workers, vocational rehab counselors, health care providers, and other service providers. The Partners in Health Care: Advocacy & Leadership Summit will help the participants to learn more about the collaborative measures that are important to have a successful transition from pediatric healthcare to adult healthcare during the lifetime of a person with special healthcare needs.
