- FREE FOR ALL NO REGISTRATION THIS YEAR

- All works need to be done en plein air within the determined painting zones.
- In case of rain, the event will go on. Bad/dangerous weather may cancel the event, or move/delay certain events.
- Be considerate. Do not block entry ways, sidewalks, streets, driveways.
- DO NOT park along the side of Parkway. There are side streets and parking lots that can be used.
- DO NOT drive on grass.
- DO NOT drive or park on walking paths (along Parkway). Vehicles are not allowed on these trails.
