behind the scenes	things that happen out of the view of the public	Watch the news at 7, we'll be going behind the scenes at an abattoir in Devon.
behind the times	outdated	My car is a little behind the times, I'll buy a new one soon.
come from behind	win/succeed after being in a losing position	The youngster is coming from behind. Can he take the champion's crown?
wet behind the ears	immature, naive, inexperienced	The new apprentice is a little wet behind the ears, but he'll be great in a few months.
