FAMILY FUNDRAISING PROGRAM

The school funding guidelines of the Archdiocese of Newark states that 10% of a school's operating budget must come from fundraising activities. FUNDRAISING COMMITMENT

THE FUNDRAISING OBLIGATION CAN BE MET IN TWO WAYS

• Raise \$600.00 through approved fundraisers during the year. If this obligation is not met through fundraising, the remaining balance is to be contributed by the family of the enrolled student(s) by April 17, 2020.
