## Dear Beloved Family,

I would like to focus my March article upon the fast approaching Season of Lent, particularly from the foundation established by our recent sermon series through the Season after the Epiphany, "So You're Dead...Now What?". We have considered some of the most pertinent passages of Scripture relating to what God has revealed to us regarding the future for all disciples of Jesus following the end of our lives. While much of the material was familiar, and some of it perhaps surprising, I trust that the one common theme was hope. From our first glance at Isaiah 42, through the concepts of resurrection and kingdom, into the new Heaven and Earth and even the rewards at the time of judgment, God speaks to us of hope. God always tells His people what to expect before He does some colossal act, and our future is no exception. We need not fear that we will be forgotten, or that we will forfeit our unique character, or that others who have died before us are longing for our arrival, or that we will be bored for eternity. God has promised us so much more!

As we enter together into the contemplative Season of Lent, may we consider our hope. How do God's promises strengthen our lives today? How does our hope in Christ motivate us to make a difference in our world right now? Where do I feel hopeless, and how can Jesus live with me in those feelings too? May we stop...think...reconsider...ask questions without demanding answers and abide in Christ more intentionally than we have for a long time...and listen to God. We may be surprised what we hear if we shut up long enough to listen. In Christ's Love.
