



International policy cooperation

Dimitri has been at the center of the international cooperation on financial sector reforms since the global financial crisis. The work he led in revamping the IMF's *Financial Sector Assessment Program* (FSAP) during 2009-2011 was a pillar of those reforms. In addition, he was part of the team that negotiated the IMF's [membership](#) in the *Financial Stability Board* (FSB) in 2013, and represented the IMF in a number of FSB working groups and committees charged with monitoring the implementation of post-crisis financial sector reforms worldwide.

Based on his experience, Dimitri has been invited to lecture on the evolution of the international financial cooperation architecture in a number of university programs, including at Yale, Vanderbilt University, the William & Mary College, Oxford, and Bocconi University. He was also invited to contribute to the book *Strengthening the Links: Bridging the Gap Between the Study and Practice of International Relations* by Profs. M. Tierney, S. Peterson, D. Maliniak, and R. Powers, to be published by Oxford University Press.
