Why Should I Become A Board Member?

The West Park Forest Ridge Civic Association is a fancy name for our community group of volunteers, also known as The WPFRR Board of Trustees. The charter for our development group contains guidelines for the ongoing maintenance of areas of the development not funded by the city of North Olmsted. It also provides a structure for this board to operate in a fair and open manner.

Participation on the Board is open to anyone in residence for at least one year. The Board structure is simple; there are four Officer positions (candidates are elected), and nine Trustee positions (although we are free to expand beyond that if necessary).

Talking About Trash

- Garbage and/or recycle containers should be placed at the curb by 7:00 A.M. on pickup day. Please do not jam or overstuff the containers
- Bagged yard waste pickup **ends November 30th**
- Yard waste bags available from North Olmsted Service Department (10 per household)
- Curbside leaf collection ends **December 8th** (see city website for details)
- Bulk pickup is always the first FULL week of the month

Please remove your containers in a timely manner and don't Leave bulk items out on the wrong week.
