

Dear Community of St. Augustine

October 14 is the canonization of two men who understood and lived their lives to inherit eternal life. Today we share a brief review of their lives.



ST. PAUL VI: Born Giovanni Montini in 1897 in the town of Concesio, Italy, the future Pope Paul VI was ordained a priest at the age of 22. He served as Archbishop of Milan prior to his election as Bishop of Rome in 1963.

As pope, he oversaw much of the Second Vatican Council, which had been opened by Pope St. John XXIII, and in 1969 promulgated a new Roman Missal. He died in 1978, and was beatified by Pope Francis Oct. 19, 2014.

Apart from his role in the council, Paul VI is most widely known for his landmark encyclical *Humanae Vitae*, which was published in 1968 and reaffirmed the Church's teaching against contraception in wake of the sexual revolution. This year marks the 50th anniversary of the historic encyclical.

Prayer

Saint Paul, through your example of unrelenting love for the poor and work for world peace, you give us great hope. Grant us your strength of character to uphold the dignity of human life everywhere; to work for the reconciliation of nations and to learn to love as you did, with courage. We ask in Jesus name. El 14 de octubre es la canonización de dos hombres que entendieron y vivieron qué hacer para alcanzar la vida eterna.
Hoy compartimos una breve reseña de sus vidas.

SAN PABLO VI: Giovanni Montini nació en 1897 en la ciudad de Concesio, Italia, el futuro Papa Pablo VI fue ordenado sacerdote a la edad de 22 años. Se desempeñó como arzobispo de Milán antes de su elección como obispo de Roma en 1963.

Como Papa, supervisó gran parte del Concilio Vaticano II, inaugurado por el Papa San Juan XXIII, y en 1969 promulgó un nuevo Misal Romano. Murió en 1978 y fue beatificado por el Papa Francisco el 19 de octubre del 2014.

Además de su papel en el C.V.II, Pablo VI es más conocido por su histórica encíclica *Humanae Vitae*, que se publicó en 1968 y reafirmó la enseñanza de la Iglesia contra la anticoncepción a raíz de la revolución sexual. Este año se cumple el 50 aniversario de su histórica encíclica.

Oración

San Pablo, a través del ejemplo de tu amor continuo por los pobres y el trabajo por la paz mundial, nos das grandes esperanzas. Danos tu fuerza de carácter para defender la dignidad de la vida humana en todas partes; para trabajar por la reconciliación de las naciones y aprender a amar como tú lo hiciste, con valentía. Lo pedimos en el nombre de Jesús. Amén.

ST. OSCAR ROMERO was born into a large family on August 15, 1917 in El Salvador. He entered the seminary at the age of fourteen and was ordained a priest when he was 25 in 1942.

In 1970, he became Auxiliary Bishop in San Salvador. In 1974 he became Bishop of Santiago de María. In 1977, Romero became Archbishop of San Salvador, the capital city. The situation in El Salvador was becoming worse and he couldn't remain silent any longer. He was beatified by Pope Francis May 23, 2015. Archbishop Romero was shot while celebrating Mass March 24, 1980, during the birth of a civil war between leftist guerrilla forces and the dictatorial government of the right.


An outspoken critic of the violence and injustices being committed at the time, Romero was declared a martyr who was killed in hatred of the faith and for his vocal defense of human rights.

St. Oscar Romero (March 16, 1980)

God of the prophets, we pray for ourselves and our church that we may become prophets of justice and life to our world. If God accepts the sacrifice of my life, may my death be for the freedom of my people. A bishop will die, but the Church of God, which is the people, will never perish. I do not believe in death without resurrection. If they kill me, I will rise again in the people of El Salvador. Amen.

Querida Comunidad de San Agustín

SAN ÓSCAR ROMERO nació en una familia numerosa el 15 de agosto de 1917 en El Salvador. Ingresó en el seminario a la edad de catorce años y fue ordenado sacerdote cuando tenía 25 años en 1942. En 1970, se convirtió en obispo auxiliar en San Salvador y en 1974 fue nombrado obispo de Santiago de María. En 1977, Romero se convirtió en arzobispo de San Salvador, la capital. La situación en El Salvador estaba empeorando y ya no podía permanecer en silencio. Fue beatificado por el Papa Francisco el 23 de mayo del 2015.



El Arzobispo Romero recibió un disparo mientras celebraba la misa el 24 de marzo de 1980, durante el nacimiento de una guerra civil entre las fuerzas guerrilleras de izquierda y el gobierno dictatorial de la derecha. Crítico abierto de la violencia y las injusticias que se cometían en ese momento, Romero fue asesinado como un mártir por odio a la fe y por defender los derechos humanos.

San Óscar Romero (16 de marzo de 1980)

Dios de los profetas, oramos por nosotros y por nuestra iglesia para que podamos llegar a ser profetas de la justicia y la vida en nuestro mundo. Si Dios acepta el sacrificio de mi vida, que mi muerte sea por la libertad de mi pueblo. Un obispo morirá, pero la Iglesia de Dios, que es el pueblo, nunca perecerá. No creo en la muerte sin resurrección. Si me matan, resucitaré en el pueblo salvadoreño. Amén.



PROVISIONAL CHURCH IN CASSELBURY

Dedication ceremonies for the temporary chapel were held Sunday, 25 July. concelebrating with William D. Borders, bishop of Orlando were Fr. James E. Martinez, founding pastor; Fr. Harry A. Cassel, Prior Provincial; and Fr. Patrick H. O'Neill, Director of the Newman Centers of the Orlando diocese. Among those in the sanctuary were Fr. John McDonnell, President of Biscayne College, Miami, and Fr. Arthur J. Chappell, Provincial Secretary.

Casselbury (Seminole County) is the site of a new Augustinian parish which is situated in the central part of the state. It was established by FR. EDWARD L. DALEY, Provincial, in July 1969.

FR. JAMES E. MARTINEZ, at the time assistant pastor of St. Augustine, Troy, New York, was named the founding pastor. Bishop William Borders, bishop of Orlando (diocese founded in 1968) welcomed us with the stipulation that the Augustinians of the St. Thomas Province administer the Newman Apostolate of the diocese and the Campus Ministry of the collegiate educational institutions in the central part of the state. FR. PATRICK H. O'NEILL, who had just received his doctorate from Catholic University, was appointed to fulfill this commitment. Fr. O'Neill is in residence at our house in Casselbury. (In the current issue of the Catholic Directory, Fr. O'Neill is listed as Director of the University Apostolate with headquarters at 408 E. Lynam Street, Winter Park, Florida, 32789. Telephone: 305-644-3625).

The mother-church in the area is St. Mary Magdalen,

Maitland, Florida. It was from this parish that our foundation was formed and dedicated to St. Augustine. The new parish started with 300 families. Currently there are 410 families. Since the dedication of the temporary church in July, 1971, sixty-two new families have been registered. Many of the parishioners are military retired personnel working in the area to supplement their pensions. Others are salesmen and business representatives. Fr. Martinez tells us that the potential for growth is great. "Disney World," the Florida version for California's "Disney Land," is thirty miles southwest of our parish. Already many of our parishioners are commuting to this wonder world and employed there.

The parish property comprises fifteen acres. About two acres of this land has been cleared. The first building to go up was a social hall (see inset) which was begun in April and dedicated in July 1971. The building at the present time serves as a church. It measures 52' x 80' and it seats comfortably 350 people. The cost of the hall including the parking lot and air conditioning was \$52,500. On the present acreage,

Fr. Martinez hopes to build a church and a rectory within the next two to five years.

On an acre of ground about one and a half miles away from the church property is situated the first rectory. It is a comfortable 3 bedroom, brick house located on Crystal Bowl Lake. The living room of the house was arranged for carrying out the Liturgy and became the first chapel of the parish. Daily Mass continues to be celebrated here. The garage on the property was converted into two rooms and now serves as a parish office and a community room.

St. Augustine's under Father Martinez is functioning with a parish council of 21 members. Organization in the newly formed parish is well underway with a Woman's Guild, the Men's Club and a very active CYO. A senior high school student, Neil Collins, is now serving as president of the diocesan CYO. This past year St. Augustine's enrolled ninety elementary grade students and 22 high school students in the CCD program. About 40 parishioners attend a nearby parochial school and five are enrolled in the Catholic High School in Orlando.
