# Reflection

Can we also call on the Lord and ask Him to have pity on us? The humility of Bartimaeus is incredible and we can admire it. More importantly it must become a goal of our life. Every day we must have this courage to turn to the Lord and ask him to give us what is lacking in our lives. Most of all we need to ask our Lord for faith, hope and love. We can also ask for everything physical that we need: for money, for food, for health, for sight, for hearing, for freedom from disease, etc.

Bartimaeus is a wonderful example to us of someone who wanted something so much that he was willing to call out and ask Jesus to help him and to heal him. Bartimaeus challenges us to become as simple and as humble as he is. He is not afraid to call on the Lord, to ask to have what he wants, to insist really that Jesus help him.

Each of us can ask: what is my relationship with God? What is my image of God? Is God truly a Father for me? Is Jesus someone on whom I can call at all times? Do I have any sense of the Holy Spirit inspiring me and drawing me into the mysteries of life and of divine presence?

As we look at our own answers to these questions, we find more about ourselves and our relationship with the living God. The point is never to think badly of ourselves but only to realize how much God loves us and invites us to share in His life. Let us commit ourselves to living this incredible mystery more and more each day! Lord Jesus, have mercy on me!

Podemos también llamar al Señor y pedirle que tenga piedad de nosotros? La humildad de Bartimeo es increíble y podemos admirarla. Más importante aún, debe convertirse en un objetivo de nuestra vida. Todos los días debemos tener este valor para volvernos al Señor y pedirle que nos dé lo que nos falta en nuestras vidas. Sobre todo, necesitamos pedirle a nuestro Señor la fe, la esperanza y el amor. También podemos pedir todo lo físico que necesitemos: dinero, comida, salud, vista, audición, etc.

Bartimeo es un maravilloso ejemplo para nosotros de alguien que deseaba tanto algo que estaba dispuesto a llamar y pedirle a Jesús que lo ayudara y lo sanara. Bartimeo nos desafía a ser tan sencillos y humildes como él. No teme invocar al Señor, pedirle lo que quiere, insistir realmente en que Jesús lo ayude.

Cada uno de nosotros puede preguntar: ¿cuál es mi relación con Dios? ¿Cuál es mi imagen de Dios? ¿Es Dios verdaderamente un padre para mí? ¿Es Jesús alguien a quien puedo llamar en todo momento? ¿Tengo algún sentido del Espíritu Santo que me inspire y me lleve a los misterios de la vida y de la presencia divina?

Al observar nuestras propias respuestas a estas preguntas, encontramos más sobre nosotros y nuestra relación con el Dios vivo. El punto es nunca pensar mal de nosotros mismos, sino sólo darnos cuenta de cuánto Dios nos ama y nos invita a compartir en Su vida. ¡Comprometámonos a vivir cada día más este increíble misterio! ¡Señor Jesús, ten piedad de mí!

### ST. AUGUSTINE'S HOSTS A FOUR-DAY OKTOBERFEST

CASSELBERRY- St. Augustine's Catholic Church has been growing fast lately and 600 families now attend -- not only from Casselberry, but also Longwood, Oviedo, Winter Springs and Stirling Park.

The church is increasing the size of its hall by 50 percent to cope with this phenomenal growth and so they need money.

To pay for the construction, St. Augustine's will hold its First Annual Oktoberfest Spectacular on the parish grounds Oct. 25th through 28th, according to Terry Duffy, publicity chairman.

The festivities will begin on Thursday, Oct. 25th with a card party in the parish hall beginning at 7 p.m.

Canasta, bridge and poker will be featured to satisfy card-fanatics of all persuasions. There will also be door prizes offered, including a portable television set -- and it's all absolutely free of charge!

Friday, the 26th, will see a Fish Fry and the grand opening of the carnival, from 6 p.m. to midnight.

"There will be 15 booths sponsored by local businessmen including a penny toss, basketball throw, and a wheel of fortune plus a variety of rides," says Duffy.

"There will also be a genuine jail, manned by junior police. Anyone caught littering will be subject to arrest and their family will have to pay a fine to get them out -- just like in real life."

The carnival will continue on Saturday at 10 a.m. and the fun will be in full swing until 1 a.m. Sunday morning.

On Saturday, in addition to the games and rides, there will be bingo with prizes and a flea market offering donated goods. Beer and home-made sausage will be on sale so that families can stay all day. Dominik's will provide a special German bratwurst for the occasion.

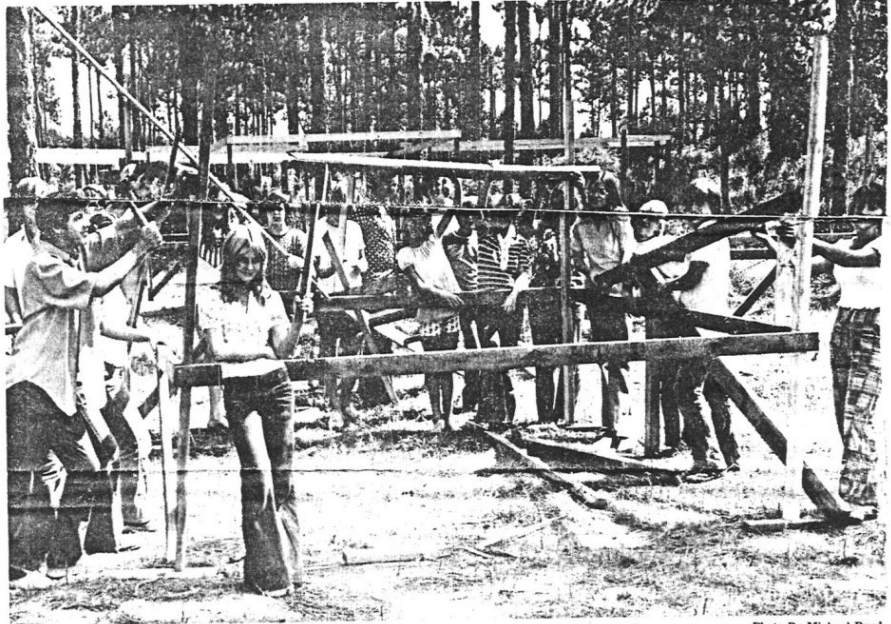
