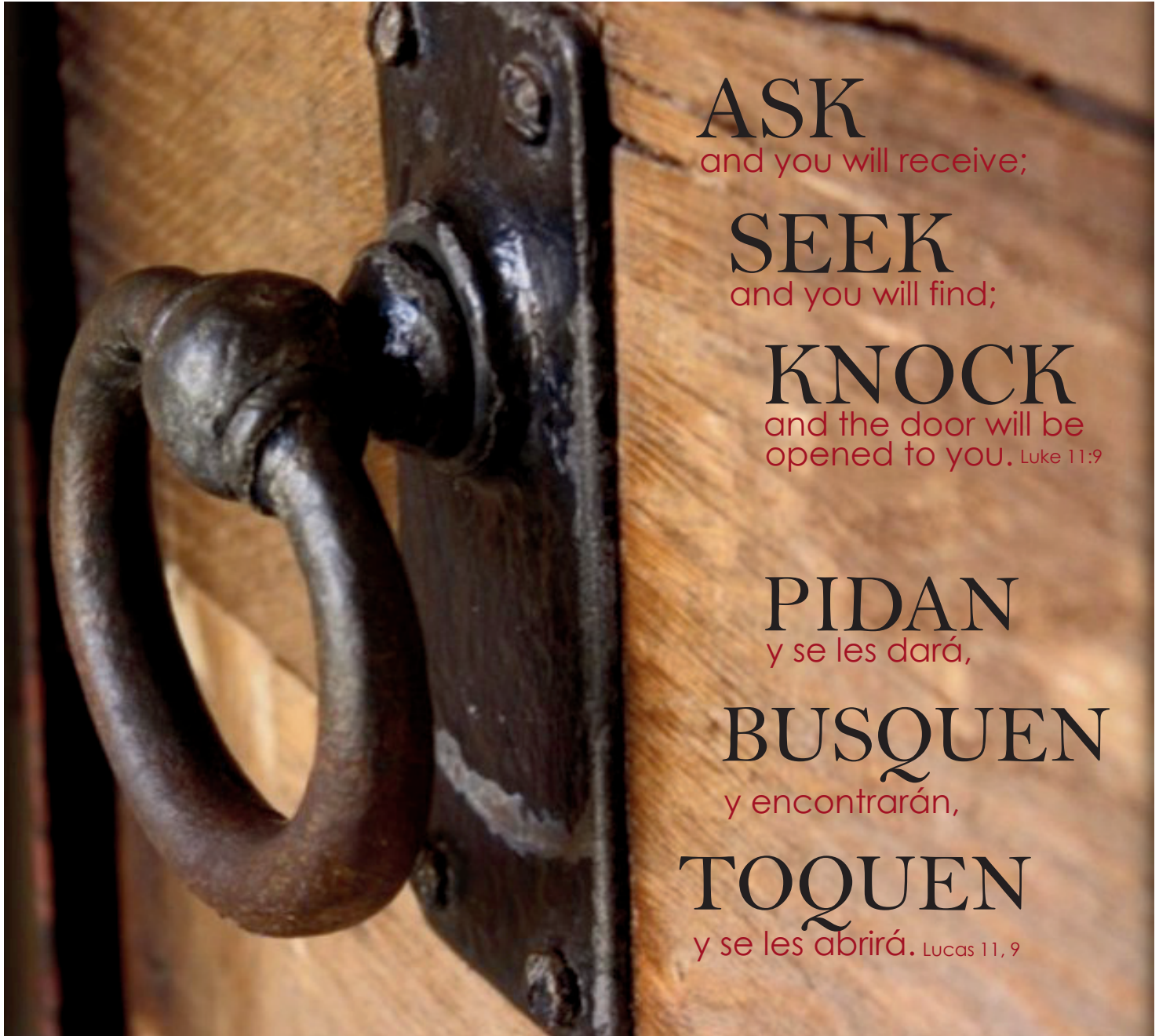

LORD, TEACH US TO PRAY...

(Luke 11:1)

Dear Community of St. Augustine,

We, humans, have the need to communicate with each other, as well as the need to communicate with God.

This weekend, in Luke's Gospel (Lk 11: 1-13) Jesus teaches us how to pray. It started with one of the disciples need and request: "Lord, teach us to pray." It is then that Jesus gives us the prayer of Our Father as our model, and with two examples teaches us that prayer must be constant.

Many Christians ask us to pray for them because they do not know how to do it. Maybe some friends or relatives may have told you, "You, who go to church, pray for me." Many people say they don't know how to pray because they feel God does not listen to them; just because what they ask does not happen.

To pray is to speak with God, to communicate with Him; but it is much more than verbally placing our petitions in His hands. Prayer is a personal relationship with God, and all our being should be involved in it. St. Augustine teaches us that the subject of prayer is man's interior, where truth and Christ dwell. Essentially, to pray is an inner attitude, which takes place in the deepest part of a human being, in his heart, the center of all spiritual life, says our Holy Patron.

The same way that we need to cultivate our human relationships and to be close to our friends, talk to our relatives, communicate with our spouses and our children, we should do the same with God. We must cultivate our relationship with God and be close to Him spending time in His presence – praising Him, giving Him thanks, seeking His wisdom, asking Him, reflecting on His Words, listening to His directions.

This week, I invite you to spend more time alone with the Lord, so He can listen to you and you may hear Him in your heart.

May God continue to bless you abundantly!

SEÑOR, ENSEÑANOS A ORAR...

(Lucas 11:1)

Querida Comunidad de San Agustín,

Los seres humanos tenemos la necesidad de comunicarnos los unos con los otros, así como la necesidad de comunicarnos con Dios.

Este fin de semana, en el Evangelio de San Lucas (Lc 11: 1-13), Jesús nos enseña cómo orar. Todo comienza con una necesidad y una petición de uno de los discípulos: "Señor, enséñanos a orar". Entonces Jesús nos regala la oración del Padre Nuestro como modelo y nos instruye con dos ejemplos concretos que la oración debe ser constante.

Muchos cristianos nos piden que oremos por ellos porque no saben cómo orar. Puede que algún amigo o familiar te haya dicho: "Tú que vas a la Iglesia ora por mí". Muchas personas dicen que no saben cómo orar, pues sienten que Dios no las escucha, porque no ven sus peticiones realizadas.

Orar es hablar con Dios, es comunicarse con Él; pero orar es mucho más que poner verbalmente nuestras peticiones en Sus manos. La oración es una relación personal con Dios, y en ella debe estar envuelto todo nuestro ser. San Agustín nos enseña que el sujeto de la oración es el hombre interior, donde mora la verdad, donde habita Cristo. La oración es esencialmente una actitud interior, que se realiza en lo más profundo del hombre, en su corazón, centro de toda la vida espiritual, nos dice nuestro Santo Patrón.

Igual que necesitamos cultivar nuestras relaciones humanas y estar cerca de nuestros amigos, hablar con nuestros familiares, comunicarnos con nuestros cónyuges e hijos, debemos hacer lo mismo con el Señor. Tenemos que cultivar la relación con Dios y estar cerca de Él pasando tiempo en Su presencia—alabándolo, dándole gracias, buscando Su sabiduría, pidiéndole, meditando acerca de Sus palabras, escuchando Sus mandatos.

Esta semana, los invito a que pasen más tiempo a solas con el Señor, para que Él los escuche y ustedes lo puedan oír en su corazón.

¡Que Dios los bendiga abundantemente!

FIVE WAYS TO “GET MORE” OUT OF MASS

YOUR BAPTISMAL RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

3) PRACTICE SILENCE AND STILLNESS AT MASS

Once you've been praying daily, it's a little easier to do this step at Mass. Try to come to Mass early so you can have a few moments of silence before the Mass begins. Now, the room itself doesn't have to be silent for you to find some quiet space in yourself to focus on what you're about to do. So don't go shushing those around you before Mass—that pretty much defeats the purpose of quieting yourself. It just puts you in a bad mood and doesn't win you more friends at church. Remember, Jesus was able to fall asleep in the boat even while a storm raged all around him and his disciples (Mt 8:23-27). So be like Jesus if your neighbors aren't as quiet as you'd like them to be. In fact, just start your Sunday Mass experience right and offer up a prayer for them.

During Mass, try to practice some silence and stillness at three appointed times:

1. at the Act of Penitence at the beginning of Mass and after each invitation to pray (“Let us pray”); these silences give us time to call to mind our sins and to offer our own silent prayers.



Try to come to Mass early so you can have a few moments of silence before the Mass begins.

2. After the readings and the homily; in these silences We meditate on what we've heard; and
3. after everyone has shared in Communion; here we each give thanks and praise to God in our hearts.

If you can, accompany your silence with some stillness as well. Closing your eyes, slowing your breathing, and quieting your body will help you to focus your mind and heart.

3) PRACTICAR EL SILENCIO Y LA QUIETUD EN LA MISA

Una vez que has estado orando diariamente, es un poco más fácil hacer este paso en la Misa. Intenta venir a Misa temprano para que puedas tener algunos momentos de silencio antes de que comience la Misa. Ahora, la habitación en sí no tiene que estar en silencio para que encuentres un espacio tranquilo en ti mismo para enfocarte en lo que estás por hacer. Así que no vayas a callar a los que te rodean antes de la Misa—eso derrota el propósito de calmarte. Simplemente te pone de mal humor y no te hace ganar más amigos en la iglesia. Recuerda, Jesús pudo quedarse dormido en el bote aún cuando una tormenta rugía alrededor de Él y sus discípulos (Mt 8: 23-27). Así que sé como Jesús, si tus vecinos no son tan tranquilos como te gustaría que sean. De hecho, comienza tu experiencia en la Misa dominical correctamente y ofrece una oración por ellos.

Durante la Misa, trata de practicar algo de silencio y quietud en tres tiempos señalados:

1. en el acto penitencial al comienzo de la Misa y después de cada invitación a orar ("Oremos"); estos silencios nos dan tiempo para recordar nuestros pecados y ofrecer nuestras propias oraciones.

2. Después de las lecturas y la homilía; en estos silencios meditamos en lo que hemos escuchado; y
3. después de que todos hayan compartido en comunión; aquí cada uno de nosotros da gracias y alaba a Dios en nuestros corazones.

Si puedes, acompaña tu silencio con algo de quietud también. Cerrar los ojos, reducir la velocidad de la respiración y calmar el cuerpo te ayudará a enfocar la mente y el corazón.
