Luke 12:15

...“la vida del hombre no depende de la abundancia de los bienes que posea”.

Lucas 12, 15



Today's Gospel is from St. Luke 12:13-21. Jesus was surrounded by a large crowd to whom he was giving his message of salvation. Some men in the crowd asked him to arbitrate in a family dispute over property. This Jesus refused to do. This interest in property gave him the occasion to teach his hearers, and all of us, in a very effective parable, the relative value of this world's goods.

The lesson of this parable is obvious to all, and it is perhaps as difficult to put into practice as it is obvious. To be in this world and not of it, to collect the necessary goods of this world by honest labor and yet remain detached from them, to possess but not be possessed by worldly riches, is an ideal to which our weak human nature responds very reluctantly.

A large percentage of Christians, however, do respond to the challenge bravely and loyally. They earn and use the goods of this world, while at the same time they keep God's laws and earn wealth for heaven.

There are other who resemble the foolish man described in the parable. Like him they are so enmeshed and ensnared in their desire to collect good things for their earthly life, that they forget that at any moment they may have to leave this earth and all they possess in it.

We must remember that it is not the quantity of this world's goods which we possess that will be our undoing, but the quality of the hold which they have on us. There are and will be millionaires in heaven, while many in the lower income-brackets will find themselves excluded.

No man will be excluded from heaven because he lawfully possessed some of this world's wealth. But a man will exclude himself from eternal happiness if he lets this world's wealth possess him to the exclusion of God.

The fate of the rich man in the parable need not, and should not, be ours. We still have time to stop building larger grain-bins and barns, and to turn our attention instead to collecting some treasure for heaven.

El Evangelio de hoy es de San Lucas 12: 13-21. Jesús estaba rodeado por una gran multitud a la que le estaba dando su mensaje de salvación. Algunos hombres de la multitud le pidieron que arbitrara en una disputa familiar sobre la propiedad. Jesús se negó a hacer esto. Este interés en la propiedad le dio la oportunidad de enseñar a sus oyentes, y a todos nosotros, en una parábola muy efectiva, el valor relativo de los bienes de este mundo.

La lección de esta parábola es obvia para todos, y quizás sea tan difícil de poner en práctica como lo es. Estar en este mundo y no pertenecer a él, recolectar los bienes necesarios de este mundo mediante un trabajo honesto y, sin embargo, permanecer separado de ellos, poseer pero no ser poseído por las riquezas mundanas, es un ideal al que nuestra débil naturaleza humana responde de muy mala gana.

Sin embargo, un gran porcentaje de cristianos responde al desafío de manera valiente y leal. Ganan y usan los bienes de este mundo, mientras que al mismo tiempo guardan las leyes de Dios y ganan riquezas para el cielo.

Hay otros que se parecen al hombre tonto descrito en la parábola. Como él, están tan enredados y atrapados en su deseo de recolectar cosas buenas para su vida terrenal, que olvidan que en cualquier momento tendrán que abandonar esta tierra y todo lo que poseen en ella.

Debemos recordar que no será la cantidad de los bienes de este mundo que poseemos lo que será nuestra ruina, sino la calidad del control que tienen sobre nosotros. Hay y habrá millonarios en el cielo, mientras que muchos en los niveles de ingresos más bajos se verán excluidos.

Ningún hombre será excluido del cielo porque legalmente poseía parte de la riqueza de este mundo. Pero un hombre se excluirá de la felicidad eterna si deja que la riqueza de este mundo lo posea con la exclusión de Dios.

El destino del hombre rico en la parábola no necesita y no debe ser nuestro. Todavía tenemos tiempo para dejar de construir graneros más grandes y, en cambio, centrar nuestra atención en recoger tesoros para el cielo.

FIVE WAYS TO “GET MORE” OUT OF MASS

YOUR BAPTISMAL RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

4) ACTIVELY SEEK CHRIST AT MASS

There are several ways Christ is present at Mass. Christ is present most especially in the Eucharist, and most of us learned that Christ is also present in the person of the priest who leads us in prayer. Christ is also present in the Scriptures, so much so that when we hear them read at Mass, we believe that it is Christ speaking. Last but perhaps most essentially, Christ is present in the people when they gather to sing and pray, for Jesus said, “Where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them” (Mt 18:20).

This last place may be the hardest for us to see Christ readily (remember those noisy neighbors?). But to be part of the church, we have to gather with others and learn to pray well with them, too, even if we don't know them or even like them.

- So look for Christ in someone new at Mass,
- and look for Christ in someone you might not get along with.
- See Christ as you share the Sign of Peace. Look the person in the eye, and see in them Christ in disguise.
- Look for Christ in what you see: a piece of artwork in the church you've never noticed before; the mother who



makes the Sign of the Cross on her baby; the way the sunlight shines through a piece of stained glass.

- Then listen for Christ in the Scriptures and homily, but also in the songs and prayers, in the silence and in the chatter of toddlers, in the voices of those who sing and pray with you.

Finally, seek Christ in what you do. When you make the Sign of the Cross, do so slowly, intentionally. When you genuflect or bow, stand, sit, or kneel, do so reverently and actively, that is, attend to what you're doing and place your focus on what's happening in the Mass at that moment.

4) BUSQUE ACTIVAMENTE A CRISTO EN LA MISA

Hay varias maneras en que Cristo está presente en la Misa. Cristo está presente especialmente en la Eucaristía, y la mayoría de nosotros aprendimos que Cristo también está presente en la persona del sacerdote que nos dirige en oración. Cristo también está presente en las Escrituras, tanto que cuando las escuchamos leer en voz alta en la Misa, creemos que está hablando Cristo. Por último, pero quizás lo más esencial, Cristo está presente en las personas cuando se reúnen para cantar y rezar, pues Jesús dijo: “Donde dos o tres están reunidos en mi nombre, allí estoy yo en medio de ellos” (Mt 18:20).

Este último lugar puede ser el más difícil para nosotros para ver a Cristo con facilidad (¿recuerdas a esos feligreses ruidosos?). Pero para ser parte de la iglesia, tenemos que reunirnos con otros y aprender a orar bien con ellos también, incluso si no los conocemos o si no nos gustan.

- Así que busca a Cristo en alguien nuevo en la Misa,
- y busca a Cristo en alguien con quien no te lleves bien.
- Mira a Cristo mientras comparte el Signo de la Paz. Mira a la persona a los ojos, y mira en ellos a Cristo disfrazado.
- Busca a Cristo en lo que ve: una obra de arte en la

iglesia que nunca antes habías notado; la madre que hace la señal de la cruz en su bebé; la forma en que la luz del sol brilla a través de un vitral.

- Entonces escucha a Cristo en las Escrituras y la homilía, pero también en las canciones y oraciones, en el silencio y en la charla de niños pequeños, en las voces de los que cantan y rezan contigo.

Finalmente, busca a Cristo en lo que haces. Cuando haces la Señal de la Cruz, hazlo lentamente, intencionalmente. Cuando haces la genuflexión o te inclinas, te paras, te sientas o arrodillas, hazlo con reverencia y activamente, es decir, atiende lo que estás haciendo y enfócate en lo que está sucediendo en la Misa en ese momento.
