## The Timbers Association Pool Facilities Rules

The following are general rules and usage requirements of the Timbers Association Swimming Pool. More detailed rules will be posted at the pool and on the Timbers Website (www.Timbers-hoa.org). These rules and regulations are designed to assure the safe, sanitary and orderly operation of our pool. All members and their guests are expected to abide by these rules and are responsible for any damage they may cause.

1. Pool Management, Control and Enforcement of Rules

Titan Pool Service is our pool management company and has complete authority to enforce all pool rules or any other instruction issued by the lifeguards for the safe operation of the pool or the pool building.

2. Pool Hours for the 2019 Season are:

School Hours	Monday through Friday - 4:00 to 7:00 PM Saturday, Sunday and Holidays- 12:00 PM to 8:00 PM
Summer Hours	Daily - 12:00 Noon to 8:00 PM
Labor Day	12:00 Noon – 6:00 PM

- 3. Pool Admission
  - a. All homeowners of the Timbers Association in <u>good standing</u> are authorized to use the pool facilities. All pool users must have a pass issued by the Timbers Association (children under the age of 2 are not required to have a pass).
  - b. Four (4) pool passes will be mailed to each homeowner. If your household requires additional passes you will need to fill out the registration form included or fill out the form online.
  - c. Children age 11 and under must be accompanied by an adult (age 16 or older). Children 12-15 with a valid pass may be admitted to the pool without an adult. Unaccompanied children must pass a rigorous swim test before being allowed without an adult.
  - d. <u>Guest passes</u> are available for purchase. They are sold in books of 5 passes for \$10.00. Send a stamped, self-addressed envelope with a check for the desired amount to:

e. Guests may be admitted to the pool under the following conditions:

(1) Guests - A guest of a pool member may be admitted with a guest pass and when accompanied by an adult <u>member</u>. A household cannot bring more than five (5) guests at any one time. Guest(s) may be refused entrance to alleviate overcrowding of the pool.

(2) Non-swimming Guests -- A guest, not intending to swim and entering the pool enclosure in street clothes, may enter the area with a member without charge at the discretion of the Manager.

- f. The pool is a family atmosphere and appropriate language, music and behavior is expected.
- g. Swimming lessons given by the lifeguards may be arranged by Pool Manager.
