HFTP's Mid-Florida Chapter will be hosting our 16th annual Charity Golf Tournament to benefit Camp Boggy Creek. We are seeking bids to host the event in September/October 2018. The event will be an 18-hole four person scramble golf tournament.

The dates we are looking at are Friday September 21st, 28th or October 5th, with a shotgun start time of 12:00pm or 1:00 pm. Our tournament includes closest-to-the-pin and longest drive as well as hole-in-one contests. In past years we have averaged over 80 attendees to our tournament. We normally set-up registration at 11:00 am which requires 4 registration tables and 8 chairs. We provide our players with donated box lunches sodas and sports drinks at registration. We also provide donated sodas, sports drinks and beer on the beverage carts (once the donated product runs out, then the beverage carts are cash basis). We also have an awards function after the tournament with a buffet TBD and a possible cash bar.
