## I. The Case and the Decision

The Applicant has sought a Travel Agency Commissioner's (referred to herein after as "TAC") review of the alleged abuse of dominant position over the Moroccan market, supposedly committed by the Member Airline Royal Air Maroc vis-à-vis the Moroccan Travel Agencies. Considering that the referred subject matter is out of the TAC's purview, this Commissioner cannot allow the review. In fact, the scope of competence of the TAC is established in Resolution 820e, Section 1.1; consequently, in case the Applicant would want to pursue this review, it would have to address it to the local Courts.

In addition, according to the above mentioned Resolution, Travel Agencies' Associations are not allowed to seek requests for review at the TAC Office, this right has only been conceived for Accredited Agents or Applicants individually considered.
