NOTE:

This summarized decision is being posted as the Parties have received it. Occasional requests for clarification are not posted. However, should any Stakeholder requests it, a copy of such clarification will be sent to her/him.

Decision:

This Office supports the Applicant's request to commence a repayment agreement until mid December 2016.

Having stated the above and taking into account that the DIP, as stated by IATA, is only valid until 31 March 2017 the "*Repayment Agreement*" has to be in 4 instalments, namely:

- 1) 20 December 2016
- 2) 20 January 2017
- 3) 20 February 2017
- 4) 20 March 2017: where also the mandatory interest and if any fees will be added.

March 20, 2017 will be an absolute deadline and this would allow IATA to claim whatever should be left from the DIP providers.

The Applicant might understand that there is, of course, no limitation for you to settle ahead of schedule and by that enabling you to reapply as Accredited Agent.

IATA please prepare the "*Repayment Agreement*" accordingly.

This Decision is effective as of today.
