The Case and Decision:

As a result of the Annual Financial Review the Agent was required to have a financial guarantee in place by today. Being a newly accredited Agent there was confusion regarding whether the Default Protection Insurance being sought from CBL covered IATA as well as the TCF.

The delay associated with this misconception resulted in the required guarantee not being in place by 6 March 2013 and hence the Agent sought interlocutory relief for a period of 3 to 5 working days in order to achieve same.

Both parties have agreed to waive their right to an oral hearing and have allowed the writer to reach a decision based on the written information submitted. IATA SYD advises that it currently holds a financial security which however does not meet the new requirement following the annual review.

Having considered the factors involved in this case it is hereby decided as follows:-

1. The Agent is granted interlocutory relief until Wednesday 13 March 2013.
