**The Case and Decision:**

In the core Decision the Agent was granted interlocutory relief until 30 April 2013 in order that the IATA Global Assessor could complete the examination of the Agent's financial statements.

As the assessment is yet to be sighted, the Agent has sought a further period of relief on the grounds that even if the assessment was received in the next few days the logistics of having any required financial guarantee in place by 30 April 2013 would be doubtful bearing in mind the intervening public holidays and weekends and the time consumed in sending and receiving the guarantee documents.

As at this stage there is no definite time frame for the assessment's completion it is considered reasonable that the Agent's request be granted.

Consequently it is hereby decided as follows:-

1. The Agent is granted a further period of interlocutory relief beyond 30 April 2013 to Tuesday 14 May 2013.
