The Case and Decision:

In brief, in the absence of the Agency's Directors overseas the staff member responsible for administration, who subsequently left without notice, overlooked renewing the Agency's bank guarantee by the due date. On returning the Agent contacted the writer on 27 February 2014 requesting an extension to comply with IATA's requirement. This was needed in order to transfer funds from elsewhere and execute the guarantee and a submission date of no later than 15 March 2014 was requested.

Both Parties have waived their rights to an oral hearing and have allowed the writer to reach a decision based on the written information submitted as provided for in sub paragraph 2.3 of Resolution 820e. The Agent has also complied with the within 30 days time frame to seek a review as detailed in sub paragraph 1.2.2.1 of the same Resolution. IATA has indicated acceptance of a short period of interlocutory relief.

A credible case for review has been established and the circumstances warrant an opportunity to be granted to the Agent to rectify the omission of others.

Hence it is hereby decided as follows:-

1. The Agent is granted a period of interlocutory relief until Saturday 15 March 2014.
