The Case and Decision

IATA suspended the Agent's ticketing authority and sought a review of the Agent, as a result of it allegedly misusing the ticketing system by adopting manual pricing for nearly 150 tickets, resulting in an approximate PKR 3.1 million loss to an Airline.

On being contacted by the writer, the Agent explained that it had fired the two employees discovered to have been responsible for the abuse of the ticketing system. The Agency's Management had met with the Airline's local Executives, had expressed their desire to cooperate and had paid the carrier PKR 3.1 million for any losses incurred by the Airline. The Agent had also settled the BSP billings due at that time. The Agent was regretful for the incident and had retained a professional recruiting company to check on the backgrounds of potential employees.

This Office sought confirmation via IATA that the Airline was satisfied with the *ad hoc* settlement made by the Agent, which proved to be the case.

In considering this matter, the writer commends the Agent for the expeditious and responsible action it took, once the ticketing abuse was detected.

The Parties have complied with the terms of Resolution 820e and were placed on notice, as required by sub paragraph 2.3 of the Resolution, that in the writer's judgement an oral hearing was not necessary and that the decision would be based on the written information submitted.

Based on the foregoing it is hereby decided as follows:-

1. the Agent's ticketing authority is to be re-activated without delay.
