NOTE:

This summarized decision is being posted as the Parties have received it. Occasional requests for clarification are not posted. However, should any Stakeholder requests it, a copy of such clarification will be sent to her/him.

Consideration and Decision:

Acknowledging IATA's need for clarity and consistency in applying Resolutions I find that IATA has followed proper procedures by serving the Applicant a Notice of Termination in February, to be executed last day of March.

Having stated the above, considering the circumstances (the reason for the "late payment" and the Applicant's long and clean record), especially given the consent from IATA's Member Airlines (QR, SV and EG), who owe the vast majority of the debt, I will grant interlocutory relief to stay the termination action, provided at least 20% of the debt is settled not later than 16 April 2018.

A repayment agreement for the rest of the outstanding is to be signed within 2 business days after IATA has outlined the repayment agreement.

This Decision is effective as of today.
