DECISION 2019 – 04 - 10 TRAVEL AGENCY COMMISSIONER – AREA 3

Oasis Travels (Pvt) Ltd. ("the Agent") IATA Code 27-3 0076 Karachi, Pakistan.

Respondent:

Agency Administrator, International Air Transport Association ("IATA") Singapore.

The Case and Decision:

The Agent contacted this Office on 30 March 2019 stating that it had now settled all outstandings and sought reinstatement of accreditation for its Karachi and Lahore locations. The subject decision had required the Agent to settle all outstandings by 29 October 2018, submitting a financial security acceptable to IATA for a period to be advised by IATA, complying with all the conditions for reinstatement, and paying all fees and charges associated therewith. It had repaid the default protection insurance provider the amount that had been claimed by IATA. Documentation to that effect was provided.

On seeking input from IATA the writer was advised that "the agent should have complied with the Reinstatement Requirements on or before 29 October 2018. While this requirement has clearly not been met, in the interests of inclusiveness, we can consider reinstatement" and then listed a number of conditions to which the agent must comply in order to be accredited once more.

In considering this matter it would only be fair for the writer to endorse the offer put forward by IATA.

That being the case it is hereby decided as follows:

1. the Agent's accreditation is to be reinstated subject to it complying with the following conditions:

- (a) providing a financial security of PKR 538,915,000.00 (USD equivalent USD 3,820,260)
- (b) paying the Late Remittance Recovery Charges of USD 66,969.83
- (c) paying the 2019 Annual Agency Fees of USD 862.90.

Such conditions to be complied with by 22 May 2019.

This Decision is effective as of today.
