- Meetings are once a month in the morning.

☐ **ARTS IN EDUCATION**

- The Arts in Education Committee meets to discuss cultural and educational programs that are brought to HHH schools for students to enjoy.
- Meetings are once a month in the morning.

☐ **BUDGET**

- The Budget Committee reviews all aspects of the current and proposed HHH district budgets.
- Meetings are once a month in the morning.

☐ **DIVERSITY**

- The Diversity Committee meets to embrace the differences that make up our community and organizes the annual Unity Fair.
- Meetings are in the morning

☐ **FACILITIES**

- Representatives tour all school facilities and address topics such as capital &, plant projects and building maintenance issues.
- Meetings are once a month in the morning.

☐ **HEALTH/WELLNESS**

- The Nutrition/Wellness Committee focuses on the school lunch program and wellness program/HHH Wellness Fair.
- Meetings are once a month in the morning.

☐ **PUBLICITY**

- The Publicity Committee maintains and updates the PTA website, issues press releases and helps units contact local news media regarding HHH events.
- Meetings are once a month online.

☐ **SPECIAL EVENTS**

- The Special Events Committee is responsible for organizing the annual Founders' Day dinner and other fundraising events district-wide throughout the year.
- Meetings are once a month in the evening.

☐ **PRC/TASK FORCE (Parent Resource Center)**


- The PRC Committee arranges workshops to educate parents in the district on various topics affecting children such as bullying and internet safety.
