- Meetings are once a month in the morning.

BUDGET

- Reviews all aspects of the current and proposed HHH district budgets.
- Meetings are once a month in the morning.

DIVERSITY

- Meets to embrace the differences that make up our community. Organizes the annual Unity Fair.
- Meetings are in the morning.

FACILITIES

- Representative tour all school facilities and address topics such as capital & plant projects and building maintenance issues.
