Dear Parents/Guardians of High School Seniors:

The Half Hollow Hills PTA Council would like to inform you of our High School Senior Scholarships. The mission of PTA is to be a strong advocate for the education and well-being of every child. The HHH PTA Council offers \$2,000 scholarships to **graduating high school seniors from HS East and HS West**, who reside in the HHH Central School District #5 and are current members of their high school PTSA.

Through our scholarship program, HHH PTA Council works to support students who are focused on achieving career goals through higher education. In evaluating each application, the Scholarship Subcommittee will also consider service and participation in school activities, community involvement and scholastic merit.

In order to receive a scholarship, the student must show proof of full-time enrollment in an accredited college or university or a technical institute in the summer or the fall semester immediately following high school graduation. The scholarship checks will be made payable to the secondary institution. All funds for the scholarships were raised through fundraising events earmarked for the HHH PTA Council Scholarship Fund.

In order to ensure all academic levels are rewarded, half of the scholarships will go to students with an average of 70-85%, the other half will go to students with an average of 85% and higher. Transcripts must be included in the application.

Applications for this scholarship are to be filed by April 4, 2019, in each High School Guidance Office. If you have any questions or problems filling out the application, please contact your guidance counselor. PTA Council will announce the names of the winners at the Senior Awards Night in each respective High School. At that time, further information will be given to the recipient of the scholarship on the next step of the process.
