Thank you for your interest in Idaho Capital City Kennel Club (ICCKC). We are a non-profit corporation founded in 1956 to further interest in purebred dogs and promote responsible dog ownership. ICCKC sponsors AKC conformation shows, (AKC purebred dogs only), and obedience, rally, and agility trials, and tracking and Canine Good Citizen tests (with either purebred or mixed-breed dogs). We sponsor educational programs for exhibitors, breeders, and dog owners. Regular membership meetings are held the fourth Tuesday of each month (except July and December) at 7 p.m. at Idaho Fish and Game, 600 South Walnut St., Boise, Idaho. Any person interested in dogs is welcome.

Membership Process Information

Membership is open to any interested person, 10 years of age or older in good standing with the AKC.

To become a member:

1. Attend at least two ICCKC meetings prior to completing the application process. (Use this time to find sponsors, learn about volunteer opportunities, and how the club works.)
2. Complete the attached "ICCKC Application for Membership" form.
3. Sign and agree to abide by the attached "ICCKC Code of Ethics."
4. Select two sponsors from among the membership of the club to complete the attached "Sponsor's Form." Responsibilities and qualifications of sponsors are listed on the form. The two sponsors should not be related to you or to each other by blood or law.
5. The application fee is: annual membership dues - \$10, plus \$5.
6. Submit to the ICCKC Membership Chair your completed ICCKC Membership Application, the signed Code of Ethics, the two completed Sponsor forms, the application fee, (cash or checks to ICCKC) and if you are a junior (under age 18) a waiver of liability signed by a parent or guardian.
7. Your completed application will be read at the first ICCKC general membership meeting following its receipt. You need to be present at this meeting or the reading will be postponed until the next meeting when you are present. After the first reading, your name will be published in the next edition of the ICCKC "Courier," (club newsletter). Members will be invited to send comments to the Membership Chair.
8. Approximately four weeks following the Courier announcement of your name, the Membership Chair will present your membership application and any written comments to the ICCKC Board of Directors for its recommendation.
9. The second reading of your application takes place at the next general membership meeting after the Membership Chair has received the Board's recommendation. You need to be present at this meeting, or the reading will be postponed until you are able to attend. Members will vote on your application.
