2023 JURIED INDIAN ART COMPETITION

ELIGIBILITY:

All participants who wish to enter must be a member of a federally or state-recognized American Indian tribe and currently residing in North Carolina.

ART CATEGORIES:

Pottery/Basketry

Painting/ Drawing

Textiles/ Regalia (decide if you want the beadwork or the Regalia judged)

Beadwork/ Jewelry (submission of any regalia in this area will be judge on its beadwork alone)

Sculpture (bone, wood, clay, stone, and gourd)

Mixed Media (this category will also include any work that falls in the above categories that fails to get at least 3 entries

ELIGIBILITY OF ENTRIES:

- Must be a member of a state or federally recognized American Indian tribe living in North Carolina or a member of a state or federally recognized NC tribe living in another state
- Only original art produced by the Artist listed that has been created within 2 years of show date will be accepted
- Submissions are limited to 3 pieces per artist
- Unframed paintings and prints will not be considered for entry unless deep canvas design
- All submissions must be received by 11am, Thursday, March 9, 2023 to Wanda Altmore. Art
 work can be hand delivered on Wednesday, March 9, 2023 between 3:00pm and 9:00pm and
 Thursday, March 9, 2023 between 9:00am and 11:00am.
- Absolutely NO LATE SUBMISSIONS will be accepted
- All submissions must be accompanied by a photo or photocopy of the work and a written description of each piece of art.
- Submissions must be properly packaged or crated.
- All submission forms should be turned in by Wednesday, March 7, 2023.

ENTRY FORM: Please complete one entry form for each submission. Label all entries with entry form below. Make additional copies if needed. Any entries without/incomplete entry forms will not accepted. Please make sure you read over the art competition information carefully before signing the entry form.

SAFETY OF ENTRIES: United Tribes of North Carolina will make every effort to keep all artwork safe and locked at all times. However, we will not be responsible for the theft, loss or damage of artwork. There will be someone in the room at all times when the art room is open. The door will be locked at all other times.

AWARDS: Ribbons and certificates will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, 3rd and Honorable Mention in each category. The first place winners will be announced during the morning General Assembly on Saturday, March 11, 2023.

DELIVERY AND PICK-UP:

No one will be allowed to collect other artist's artwork unless it is specified at time of delivery. Participants are responsible for having artwork delivered to the NC Indian Unity Conference between the hours of 3pm and 6 pm on Wednesday, March 8, 2023 and 9 am and 11 am on Thursday, March 9, 2023. Judging will take place between 11am and 2pm on Thursday, March 11, 2023. There will be an Art Reception on Thursday, March 9th at 5pm. All artwork MUST be picked up between 5pm -7pm on Friday, March 10, 2023 or before noon on Saturday morning.
