After many years of helping the City of God Ministries in **Trinidad**, we move **WITH** them for a third straight year to take what we know and build together in a third country. This is another chance for all of us to dive deep into a cross-cultural experience that excites our spirits and gives an energizing boost to our church partners near Parika, Guyana.

Our days will be filled with a building project that will establish another church in Zeelugt, a suburb of Parika. Skilled workers are appreciated, but not required. We will hammer, saw, paint and mix cement in the day time. Our nights will be filled with team devotionals and team times with our Guyanese hosts where we will share thoughts about evangelism and teach practical ways to start spiritual conversations.

This will be a *"developing world experience"*. We will sleep and eat in the homes of our gracious hosts. Some accommodations may not be what one is used to in the USA, but it will give you an eye-opening perspective of God's world and a stronger appreciation

WANTED: Men and women who are willing to meet as a small group for pre-trip training, are willing to lift a hammer, trowel or paint brush during hot summer-like days and are willing to learn and then teach what they know about being a Christian in the "real world".

ESTIMATED COSTS: Depending on airfare and whether or not a teammate has a passport and is in need of immunizations (Yellow Fever, Malaria, Hepatitis), our total cost are usually \$1,200-\$1,500.
