Use of appropriate methodology/analyses	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Poor or inappropriate use of methods/analyses 2. Limited use of appropriate methods/analyses 3. Strength of conclusion	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. No clear conclusion 2. Conclusions in the presentation but not clearly articulated 3. Presentation includes conclusions but they are not strongly made or supported by the presentation 4. Good conclusion that includes all the main points 5. Exceptionally strong conclusion that ties all the threads together
