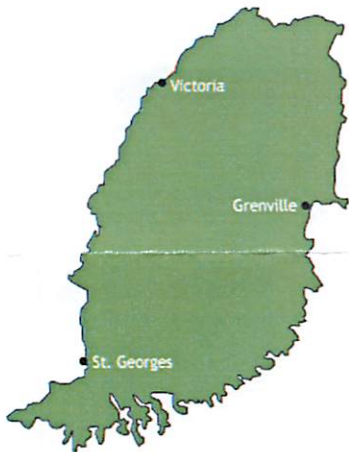

Dear Supporting Friends,

It gives me great pleasure to write to you. We pray that all is well and that you are prospering in the Lord. Our family is doing wonderful. Aasia is doing very good, she took one year on December 5th 2016. She is already talking saying mommy, daddy, Ayla, come, go and many other things. Ayla too is doing well she has started music class learning to play the Violin and Piano. She had her Fifth birthday on February 11th 2017 she feels big being five. She continues to grow in the Lord and excels in school too. Anesta continues to labor and works in Sunday school and the organizing of the Ladies amongst other things. Please continue to pray for us.

The work here at victory continues to grow, we had two souls saved for the year so far and are in counsel with others who are wanting to get saved but are being delayed for other reasons.

We were expecting to have had our foundation up at Chantimelle according to plans. This delay is because of the selling party's bank that has an interest in the land due to a mortgage. We have crossed all the legal hurdles in relation to that a long time ago. They have sent in their release letter for the land and so on. At this time, all we've been waiting for is for the Bank to convey to their lawyer the amount of monies that will be allotted to them, the Bank, and the sum that goes to Mr. Barry the seller. When that is done, it will be placed in the Conveyance that has been prepared about ninety days now. I am not enjoying the waiting but our laws dictate the sums should be placed in the conveyance for transparency of the transaction. In that way when it's all said and done we will provide you with a copy and you too can see amount paid for the Lots.

After many calls, I made to our lawyer, she has written to the Bank asking them

to hasten the process and provide the relevant information to their attorney, so he can pass it on to them as the case may be, considering my plans to build. Enclosed is a copy of the short letter. Please pray for us since we are now in March and are still without our deed. The delay as of now has compromised our plans of getting this building up within this year and will take a special effort to accomplish this for this year. One thing I do know, God is able, a blessing delayed is not a blessing denied.

When we overcome this bump and construction starts, if individuals or church groups wants come down and help us build you are more than welcome. We can coordinate this when the new plans are set in order. First I await the deed. I have no idea when I would be receiving it, am sure it couldn't be long again. When that is achieved, I will forward information to you outlining the course by Gods help. Just pray for us in this matter. Through all these ups and downs we baptized a young man for Chantimelle on February 12th 2017, Danny Scott is his name and he is on fire for God.

Please continue to pray for us at that other outreach. In Mt. Rich and for the souls that trusted Jesus as Lord and Savior. It feels so good to be a laborer in Gods vineyard.

I take this line to say thanks for your prayers and much needed faithful financial support over the years.
