men and women that God put together this year as camp counselors, kitchen help, game technicians and other posts was a huge blessing.

For the past five years, since the church was started in Danli, we have used different camp sites for our

youth. However, many of you know that God has provided a property to be used for the camp here close to Danli. I am unsure if we will have it ready to go by January of next year, but we have started building. The project will cost around \$85,000. We have about half of the amount already committed!!! This year three campers accepted Christ as their personal Savior and 24 surrendered to serve the Lord full-time.

In addition to those saved at camp, we were able to see many other people make professions of faith in the Lord. So, on February 4 we were able to have a baptismal service. Twenty people came ready to follow the Lord in Believers' Baptism. As an added blessing, Pastor Pedro

Avila brought six people from the church in Los Robles to be baptized, and he was able to perform his

first baptism! I was able to provide some moral support (3).

We ended our eventful month with our annual Valentines Day dinner. This year each couple had one month to do 13 different tasks. Such as: Do a Bible study together, go on a picnic, take a walk in the park, go out to eat, etc... This one event has strengthened many marriages in the church.
