Also, we met in a Café with Erika, a Japanese lady that is married to a Liechtensteiner. Lindsay met her months ago in a park. We thought her husband was coming, but he did not. However, we were able to spend some time with her and trust for this door to open further. God also blessed and we met a Swiss

woman, Debora. Ruth and her son played together in a park. We are trusting the Lord for open doors with these and others.

Literature Campaign: We have been able to restart distributing literature and invitations throughout Balzers, Triesen, & Trübbach. We are focusing on doing smaller areas within these towns more often. Please continue to pray for God's blessings on these efforts. Perhaps you remember Emmanuel. He is the Nigerian refugee living in Liechtenstein that heard the gospel back in February. God providentially brought our paths together with he and his girlfriend during a time of literature distribution. We conversed a bit with them and invited them to the Sunday meetings.
