

Many ladies have this same problem as family ties are severed, and they fall right back into their old ways. Please pray that God will intervene, that she will find a good church, and that she will not end up back in prison.



Together they are praying about God's call upon their lives and asking Him to clarify their role in the future of the work.


Anniversary in Switzerland. We all spent some very enjoyable time together in Liechtenstein!

Since our last prayer letter many events have taken place and many wonderful people have made professions of faith in Jesus Christ.

**LEFT KNEE SURGERY** - I must take a medical furlogh for the next three to six months to have a total knee replacement on my left knee. The *surgery has been scheduled for July 16th* at the VA Hospital in Salisbury NC where I will spend at least two days in the hospital. Then after surgery I will be moved to a rehab facility for another two weeks, since our RV is not

conducive to the needs for proper recovery. While there I will begin in house Physical Therapy and that will continue as outpatient for up to three months after the surgery. Please keep this surgery and my recovery in your prayers that all will go well. This is another opportunity to witness to those I can while facing recovery.

MORE MINISTRY NEWS - Two seniors in High School planning on going into the service called to seek advice on the military. After spending nearly an hour talking with each of them about what the military is really like, one who professed to be a "Christian" said he had to go home and seriously rethink his plans, while the other one just thanked me for sharing the informing with him. A Christian Vietnam Veteran we met told me he was Ashamed of serving, because there was nothing good that came out of it. We gave him a copy of the testimony of Mrs. Tam Bowman, a Vietnamese woman who was led to the LORD by a Christian Soldier, and the next day he said "I never knew all that... Thank You"! Finally we were called to assist a Marine on leave whose vehicle had broken down. He needed a new engine and could not afford the repair, BUT GOD! He professed to be an atheist yet he could not figure out why so many people were helping a complete stranger. The shop doing the repair was donating their time and labor as well as putting him up in a motel during repairs. We drove an hour and a half just to witness to this young man and of course pay the remaining portion of his repairs. After witnessing to him for over an hour about how God was trying to get his attention, he allowed me to pray for him and said "I have a lot to think about"! What is the price of a soul? This month has been quite eventful for us. We have seen God do many great things. He has protected us as we traveled thousands of miles. We spent most of the time in TN, KY, and GA. The Lord Blessed with 3 churches promising support. God has blessed with many good meetings and opportunities to preach and share our burden for Ghana.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The Bible says that "As cold waters to a thirsty soul, so is good news from a far country." Pro\_25:25 so let me begin by sharing how God has been blessing us here in Scotland. We have had many people come and visit our Church recently with just about a new visitor every week. They have been coming from our local area and from much further afield. It has been truly amazing to see these people coming all looking for a place where the Bible is preached and upheld. One visitor told me that he was despairing that he would be able to find any church that truly preached the Bible and salvation through Christ alone! Recently as part of our outreach we have begun a youtube channel of our Church services in Scotland. You can search youtube for Bible Baptist Glasgow and you will find it. This is because many people who have visited our Church have been watching preachers from the United States online and have said that they wished that they could have a church here in Scotland that preached like that. Now some of those youtube preachers have been good but some have been very bad and are spreading false doctrine and hatred. So, I wanted to provide an alternative for people in Scotland and in the rest of the United Kingdom to hear good preaching from Scotland. It has resulted in many new visitors coming to the Church and many of them have decided to stay and are coming every week. Praise the Lord. Some though have brought false doctrine and after hearing the preaching of the Word of God have since moved on.

Not only have we been putting out sermons online but we also continue door to door witnessing and street preaching and evangelism. We have had a good number of people get saved on the streets recently and we have been passing out Bibles to these new believers in Christ. One man who was saved and received a Bible is called Patrick and I would ask you to pray for him that he would go on with the Lord. Our bible institute is doing very well and the two young men we are training for the ministry have responded very well to what they have been learning. Recently we have been going through the subjects hermeneutics and homiletics so they can study the bible in an organised manner and can prepare sermons that will be sound biblically. This last Sunday we had one of the young men preaching in the Church, brother Grant, and he did a wonderful job, praise the Lord. There are many challenges and blessings to working in the ministry here in Scotland. One of the saddest things here for me is how alcohol and drugs destroys lives. I would ask for you to pray for one young lady in particular called Kaireen who is going through a battle at the moment. She recently was led to the Lord though brother Grant but is struggling with alcohol and drug addiction. In the area where she lives there are many people who are struggling with this problem. Many of them have taken their own lives because they just can't deal with these problems. Sadly, just vesterday I heard of another young women who had taken her life and was a friend of a young man who came to our church. It is truly heart-breaking! We are in a battle here for the souls of men and women in Scotland. Our family is doing well and Debbie continues her recovery from surgery. Thank you for your prayers and support in our ministry of reaching Scotland with the Gospel.

Dear Pastors and Praying Friends,

I just want to say Bless the Lord for the busy but blessed last two months. To God be the glory for all that he has done! Our family wants to thank

each and every one of our supporters for your prayers and faithful support. There has been so much happening in these last two months I will try to include all the Lord has done and is doing.

#### Project Kindness for Kids...

We have been able to add 4 underprivileged children to the ones who are being sponsored, which now brings us to 11 children. It was a great joy to have been able to see one of our sponsored children trust Christ as there Saviour at the recent revival at Blessed Hope Baptist Church.

#### Our First Visitors...

We've just finished 3 weeks with our PBMI Director Bro.Gary Crisp and evangelist Duane Moore. It was such a blessing to have them visit, for the Lord used them greatly. We began with a youth meeting then we had our Tri-annual Bible Institute each day the first week with a Home and Family Revival each night at Welcome Baptist Church in Buwenge. Praise the Lord for Ms. Veronica getting saved! Then we traveled to Luwero for a Revival at Blessed Hope Baptist Church where the Lord blessed and 19 souls

were saved in that week of revival! From there we traveled to Kenya to meet up with some nationals who works with PBMI.

We are in the middle of school break here, but we were able to have a meeting with a group of schools in Luzinga to a group of 2000 students and teachers! This next school term we plan to continue preaching in the schools and to follow up with many we've already been with. We spoke in our last prayer letter about the repair work on the bindery system at the print shop and I'm happy to report it's working as it should and they are putting bibles together on it as I write this letter. Replacing and upgrading printing equipment is very costly and when we finish with a piece of equipment, if it's still usable we always try to find another ministry that can use it to help them avoid the cost of buying it. Our plate making process for the printing presses has been in need of upgrading for several years so we've recently purchase a used (but new to us!) Computer to plate machine (CTP) which will speed up our plate making process and save considerable money on the cost of producing plates. This will cost VBP \$ 28,400.00 please help us pray that the money will come in to pay for the machine, maybe you would like to have a part in helping us with this if so please send your offering to VBP and make a note it's for the CTP.

Our last trip out on the road was three weeks long and since our last letter we've been in revival meetings, mission conferences and local churches in NC, SC, AL and Florida preaching and presenting the ministry and we took a few days and drove the bus to carry a group of young people to a youth conference in DeLand, FL. and it's always a joy to see our youth get stirred about the things of God and find direction for their lives.

We left Florida and drove to Brevard, North Carolina (The Wilds Camp) to enjoy the annual Vision Baptist Mission orientation. It was a blessed week.


#### **BEST NEWS**

Dear Pastors & Praying Friends,

Visitors - We had many visitors this past month: friends from Northern Ireland, missionaries to Africa, and a mission team from America.

Missions Weekend - The Shumaker family, missionaries to Burkina Faso, was able to be with us for a few days in May on their way back to America for furlough. Bro. Keith preached our missions weekend and challenged our church to get more involved in world missions.

Gospel Need in SE England - There is a great spiritual need in the Southeast of England where we live. There are very few Bible-believing churches. Many of the churches that are here are finding it difficult to reach out with the gospel, especially amongst the white English population. One English pastor told me that it is estimated that less than .05% of white English people attend a Bible-believing church. Please pray for God to strengthen existing churches and to give gospel fruit in this needy area.

Downham Baptist - God has brought together an amazing group of members at Downham Baptist. They are a small group, but each of them has shown perseverance. Pray for them to continue to grow spiritually and numerically as they continue to take on more ministry responsibility, especially with us going on furlough in August. Pray as well for more of the occasional and regular attenders to become committed members.

Preaching - Our Exodus series is coming to an end, so we are about to start my last preaching series before we leave from the book of 2 Timothy. Also, I will be teaching more lessons on why we do and don't do certain things at our church. Pray for our church to be mature and strong in the face of much false doctrine and false teaching that abounds in our world today.

Evangelism - The American mission team that was with us for a week from Pleasantville Baptist Church in Pleasantville, Iowa, helped us with a good amount of evangelism. They helped us to distribute almost 6,000 invitations as well as some street evangelism and door-to-door work.

Furlough Plans - Thank you for continuing to pray for our furlough plans. There is much to do, but God is helping us. We are working on booking our calendar and will do our best to visit our supporting churches as we are able. If your church does not support us, we would love to come by and present our ministry, as we are in need of raising additional support. Thank you!






