#### **Newspaper Corporate Thank-You**

#### **Appreciation Banner**

A "Thank You" banner will be prominently displayed at the event on the side of the announcer's platform during the Pow-Wow (logo and font according to sponsorship level.)

#### **Pow-Wow Program**

BNFC will print a minimum of 300 hundred copies of a Pow-Wow Program (15-25 pages) and distribute them free of charge to the general public and attendants of the event.

All corporate sponsors will be recognized in the Pow-Wow Program. THUNDERBIRD and EAGLE sponsors will be provided FREE advertising space in the Pow-Wow Program – size and placement in the Program varies by sponsorship level.

#### Letter

#### Volunteer

All Corporate and individual sponsors will be given the opportunity to provide in-kind

volunteers from their organizations to assist with the Pow-Wow. All corporate and individual

volunteers will be recognized on the BNFC website and social media page.

#### **Passes**

All sponsors will receive weekend passes to the event. The passes cover door entry and parking. The number of passes varies according to sponsorship level.

#### **Public Announcements**

Corporate sponsors will receive public recognition and thank you throughout the event from the pow-wow emcee. The public recognition will delivered over the public address system- the number of announcements varies by sponsorship level.

#### **Corporate Banner**

THUNDERBIRD & EAGLE sponsors are eligible to have their corporate banners (or signage) prominently displayed at the event. Banners may be dropped off and picked up at the BNFC.
