She worked with the Catholic Charities Department for Persons with Disabilities as a residential counselor, and with the National Consumer Voice for Long-Term Quality Care as an intern. However, it was the reinforcement of Christian values and public policy knowledge encompassed in her studies at Liberty University's Graduate School that propelled Jenica. Today, she volunteers with the National CASA Association as a Court Appointed Special Advocate for abused and neglected children in foster care.

Jenica is not a politician. She is an advocate who believes that government should be the power of the people, not people in power. Jenica feels that the voices of our communities are diminishing at the federal level. She strives for a restoration of how government was defined by America's founders. For over a decade Jenica has witnessed Maryland's communities consumed by opioid related deaths and an aging population relying heavily on their access to affordable health care services. As a United States Representative for the State of Maryland, Jenica looks to strengthen legislative decisions at the State and local levels. She believes that policy should be honest and fully transparent. This includes policy changes where the medical costs of citizens will be less than the costs currently afforded to federal programs.
