SALVATION

The Greek word *so·tee·ree·ah* translated “salvation”, basically means to be “delivered”. In terms of the salvation of men, it infers the meaning of being delivered from the penalty of death (separation), which is the very opposite of possessing eternal life (Romans 6:23). The Doctrine of Foreordination documents that all of the acts associated with the decrees effectuating the deliverance and positioning of God’s elect, were determined and enacted in eternity. All men deserve the payment of death as the wages of sin, but God’s elect have received the gift of eternal life. Believers are saved by His grace, not their works (Ephesians 2:8-9). The works of men do not bring about salvation therefore no works can cause one to lose it. Salvation is irreversible (it cannot be lost) i.e., it should not be considered probation. Romans 8:33-39 conveys the message that nothing can separate us from the love of God thus documenting the fact of eternal security. The salvation of God’s elect was secured exclusively by Him in eternity, thus all who are saved are also sealed unto the day of redemption (Ephesians 4:30).
