S – K 10 6 5 H – K Q 8 6 4 2 D – Q 4 C – 3

Partner (North) opens 1 Diamond and right-hand opponent (East) overcalls 2 Clubs. What call would you make, as South?

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Question 2: North - South vulnerable, as South you hold:

S – 10 7 3 H – 5 3 D – J 10 7 5 4 C – K 10 2

Partner (North) opens 1 Diamond and right-hand opponent (East) overcalls 1 Heart. As South, what call would you make?

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Question 3: East - West vulnerable, as South, you hold:

S – K H – J 7 6 4 3 D – A 9 C – K 9 8 5 3

As Dealer (South), what call would you make?

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Question 4: Both vulnerable, as South, you hold:

S – A K 7 H – Q 10 8 5 D – A J 6 4 2 C – 2

S – 10 9 8 5 H – K 5 2 D – J 8 4 C – J 7 6
