# WELCOME TO MEMPHIS

Welcome to the Memphis NABC! The American Contract Bridge League and District 10 want to be the first to wish you good luck at the tournament.

Most events will be played at the Memphis Cook Convention Center. On Wednesday, March 20, and Thursday, March 21, all bridge play will be in the Ballroom on the second floor of the convention center. Here is an overview of event locations, all on the second floor of the convention center, beginning Friday, March 22:

NABC+ and NABC Events – Ballroom Regional Teams (1 & 7:30 pm) – Southwest Hall Regional Pairs (1 & 7:30 pm) – Northwest Hall Most Regional Events (10 am & 3 pm) – East Hall Intermediate/Newcomer Events (I/N) – East Hall

#### MEMBERSHIP IS REQUIRED

A valid ACBL player number is required to play in all events at the NABC. Along with oneyear and three-year memberships, a 30-day trial membership is available to new members for \$7.99. Temporary and regular memberships can be purchased from Tournament Operations or the Check-Cashing Desk.

#### PRE-REGISTRATION REQUIRED FOR VANDERBILT. 10K KO

Registration for the Vanderbilt KO Teams is required by 6 p.m. Sunday, March 24. Entries may be purchased in the Ballroom on the second floor of the convention center.

For the 0–10,000 Knockout, the registration deadline is 10 a.m. Monday, March 25. OPENING RECEPTION

#### ENTRY FEES

A valid ACBL player number is required to play in all events at the NABC.

Players must be members whose service fees or dues are current in order to compete in any of the following NABC+ events: Kay Platinum Pairs, Leventritt Silver Ribbon Pairs, Lebhar IMP Pairs, Vanderbilt Knockout Teams, Rockwell Mixed Pairs, Silodor Open Pairs, Smith Life Master Women's Pairs, NABC+ Fast Pairs and the Jacoby Open Swiss Teams. The entry fees for these contests are **\$25** per player per session. For team events, this means **\$100** per team per session for fourperson teams, **\$125** per team per session for five-person teams, and **\$150** per team per session for six-person teams.) *Note: \$1.50 per person per session benefits the International Fund*.

Players must also be current ACBL members to play in the 0–10,000 Swiss Teams and the 0–10,000 Knockout Teams. The entry fee is **\$17** per player per session. This means **\$68** per team per session for teams of four, **\$85** per team per session for teams of five, and **\$102** per team per session for teams of six.

Regional championships are **\$16** per player per session for current members, **\$20** for inactive members. For multi-session team events of three sessions or more, the entry fee is **\$64**, **\$80** or **\$96** per session for teams of four, five or six, respectively. For team events of one or two sessions, the entry fee is **\$64** per session.

Other events are **\$15** per player per session for current members, **\$19** for inactive members. (There is no entry fee for any flight of North American Pairs.)

\* ACBL members whose dues payment is current and Life Masters whose service fee payment is current.

Starting Friday, March 22, Intermediate/ Newcomer (I/N) games begin at 10 a.m., 3 p.m. & 7:30 p.m. All I/N events will be held in the East Hall on the second floor of the Convention Center.

The **I/N Partnership Desk** guarantees you a partner if you sign up one hour prior to game time.

### ENTRY FEE SPECIAL

Players with 0-100 MPs who buy a regular-price entry March 22-24 will receive a half-priced entry for games March 29-31.

### ELECTRONIC DEVICE POLICY

The ACBL's electronic device policy allows players to bring electronic devices such as cell phones into the playing area provided that such devices are **turned off**. Further, any such equipment **must not be visible** during the session.

A violation of the policy will result in an **automatic disciplinary penalty** of one full board (or 12 IMPs at that form of scoring) for the first offense. A second offense will result in disqualification from the event.

In an effort to speed up the start of all NABC+ pairs events, please buy entries at least 15 minutes before game time. This is especially true if you expect to be a seeded pair.

### BUY YOUR ENTRY ONLINE

Don't wait in line! Buy your entries in advance for all national-level events in Memphis at BridgeWinners.com.

Entries must be purchased by 10 a.m. the day of the event EXCEPT for events that require preregistration, in which case the ACBL deadline, or the earlier of the two, applies.

A nice feature: You can buy entries in advance and be charged for the total number of sessions played after the event is over.
